Lesson Summary: When you're not truthful, you lose trust.

Memory Verse: "Anyone who lives without blame walks safely. But anyone who takes a crooked path will get caught." Proverbs 10:9 (NirV)

1. ICE-BREAKER QUESTION: Would you rather be a superhero or an astronaut?

2. PRAYER REQUESTS AND PRAYER TIME:

Here are some suggested prayer prompts if kids have a hard time thinking of something to pray for:

*If Jesus were sitting next to you right now, what would you say to him?

*Do you have a friend or family member who is sick or needs help with something?

*Did anything happen this week that you didn't like? Is there something you are worried about? Is there something you can ask God for help with?

*What is something in your life that you can thank God for?

3. MEMORY VERSE:

4. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS & BIBLE PRACTICE:

- Have kids use their table of contents to find the book of Colossians. Is it in the Old Testament or New Testament? *New*
- Find Colossians chapter 3 (big number); verse 9 (little number).
- Have your child read Colossians 3:9 out loud.

"Don't lie to one another. You have gotten rid of your old way of life and its habits."
(NIrV)

- What does this verse tell us *not* to do? *Lie to one another*
- Who in today's Bible story lied? *Gehazi*
- How can lying be a bad habit? *You can get so comfortable doing it that it becomes a regular practice*
- Why does the verse say, "You have gotten rid of your old way of life and its habits?" *Because when you become a follower of Jesus, you are a new creation. Instead of falling into old habits, you try to follow Jesus' example.*
- Did you fall into any old bad habits this week? Have you lied about something to avoid getting into trouble? If so, ask God to forgive you and help you make a better choice next time.
