ITEMS NEEDED:

- Baby: baby food (jars), formula, wipes, diapers (4-6)
- Shower: body wash, shampoo, conditioner
- Toiletry: deodorant, comb/brush, gel/mousse, razors, Q-tips
- Hygiene: toothbrushes, toothpaste, hygiene kits (men/women)
- Laundry: dryer sheets, laundry soap, laundry pods, bleach
- Cleaning: Clorox wipes, Pine Sol, trash bags (13 gl, 33 gl, 45 gl, 55 gl)
- Paper Products: paper plates/bowls, paper towels, napkins, TP
- Canned Foods: fruits, vegetables, soups, chicken, tuna, chili
- Drinks: instant coffee, dry creamer, sugar packets, Crystal Light
- Nutritious snacks: granola bars, dried fruit (nonperishable)
- Peanut butter, jelly (no glass)
- Plasticware: Plastic cutlery
- Clothing: new t-shirts, jackets, underwear and black socks
- Household: bed sheets, towels, blankets (twin or queen)
