Proper Personal Hygiene

Definition-

Practicing good personal hygiene is the key to preventing a food borne illness from occurring. Most foodborne illnesses are transmitted by people to food.

Information-

These are the steps that if followed will help in preventing a food borne illness from occurring.

Process for Proper Personal Hygiene -

- 1. Begin with proper hand washing washing hands often and frequently is the key.
- 2. Maintain personal cleanliness and avoiding unsanitary habits and actions.
- 3. Wear disposable gloves properly and when handling ready-to-eat foods, especially if wearing a band-aid.
- 4. Use new gloves when changing from one task to another and when gloves become soiled or torn.
- 5. Clean and sanitize food contact surfaces between uses and tasks.
- 6. Never touch raw food and then touch ready-to-eat foods without first washing hands.
- 7. Remember you are the key in helping prevent foodborne illnesses from occurring.
