Oven Cleaning

Definition-

The processes and procedures utilizing chemicals to clean an oven. Proper cleaning and sanitizing can destroy 99.999% of disease-causing microorganisms. Proper and routine sanitation helps ensure safe food for your customers.

Information-

Your oven should be cleaned regularly to prevent a build-up and to help prolong the life expectancy of the oven. Routinely wiping up spills reduces the amount of time necessary to clean For more information, refer to the SFSPac Procedure & Reference Guide. Always wear safety glasses and gloves when cleaning the oven.

Process for Oven Cleaning-

- 1. Daily Wipe up spills on all outside oven surfaces with SFSPac All Purpose Cleaner.
- 2. Weekly After allowing oven to cool, remove racks. Spray interior with SFS30. Let stand. Use scouring pad if needed. Wipe with cloth. Rinse with clear water.
- 3. Weekly Place racks in large trash bag. Spray with SFS30. Close bags and let sit. Open away from face, place in sink, re-spray, scrub with scouring pad and rinse thoroughly.
