Why do I need to know?

- Workday will be available to employees for payroll related actions beginning *December 16*.
- ALL employees will use Workday to request time off.
- Overtime eligible and timeslip employees will also use Workday to record hours worked.
- Supervisor/managers will be required to review and approve the actions, however, all approvals will be electronic. NO more paper!



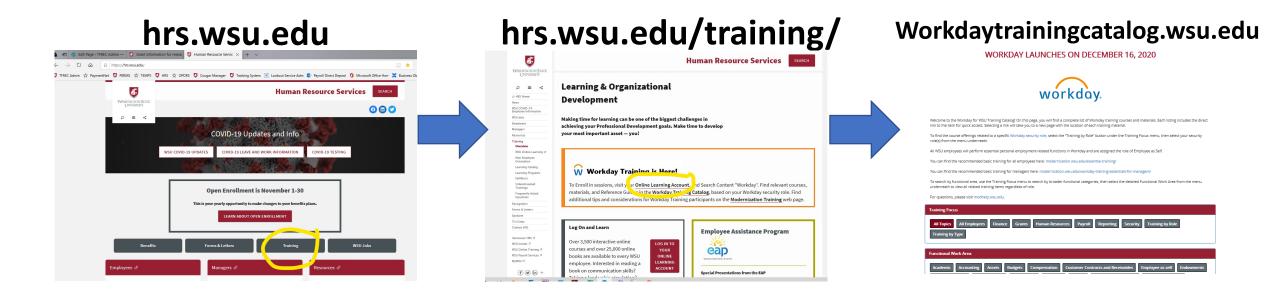
Processes being replaced by Workday

 Time off/absence (fka leave) reporting for overtime ineligible employees on the CAHNRS online leave website

 Cougar Manager for entry of timeslip hours and absence/sick leave

 Paper *Time Reports* for overtime eligible employees reporting time worked and time off.

Key Changes

 Workday will standardize time tracking and absence processes across WSU.

• It will allow us to shift from paper to *electronic* records.

 You will see automatic calculations of accruals.



Benefits

• Elimination of separate functionality between payroll and time and absence tracking.

 Allows online review and approval of time and absences.

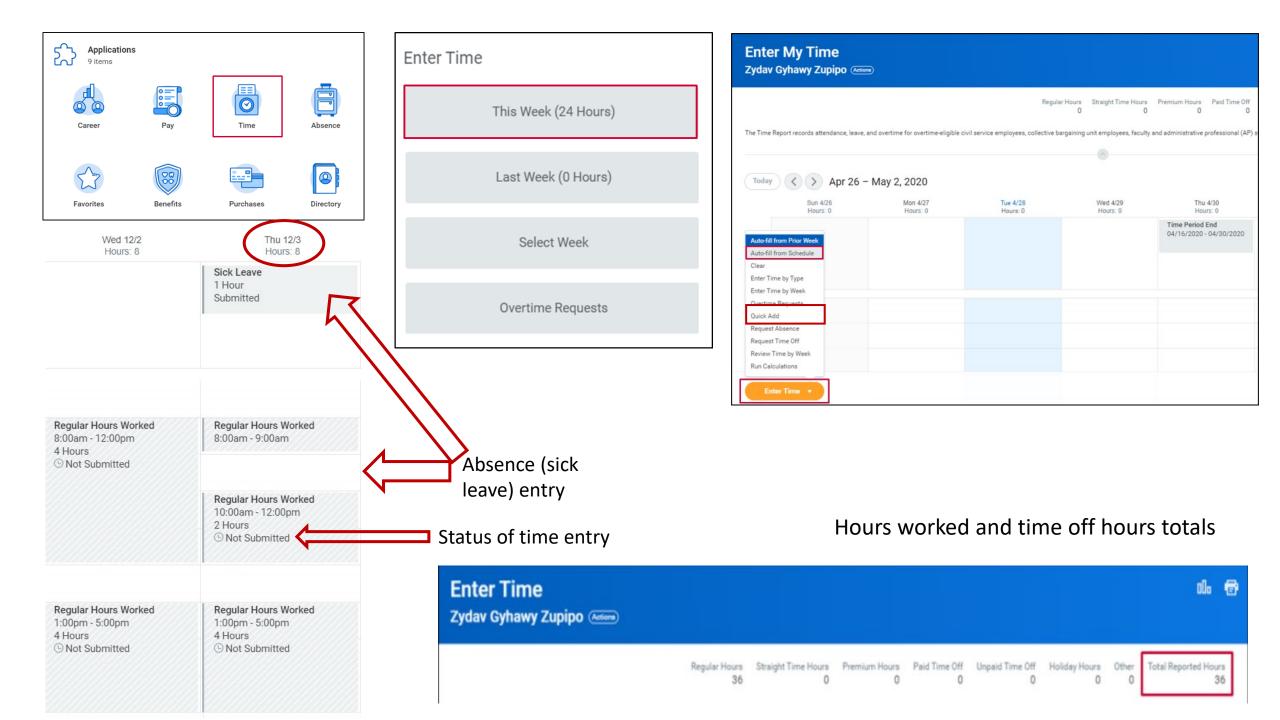
Many self service features available.



Entering Time Worked

Overtime Eligible Employees

- You will have the option to *auto fill* from a drop down menu, use the "quick add" feature or enter directly on the calendar.
- Temporary or permanent schedule changes must be submitted to your supervisor.
- To *view your schedule*: Click on the Time app on the home page and select "My Schedule".
- It is up to each program to determine if *overtime requests* will be required.
- Frequency of time submission will be based on an agreement with your supervisor (daily, weekly, per pay cycle; monthly is not recommended for this new system as previously done).

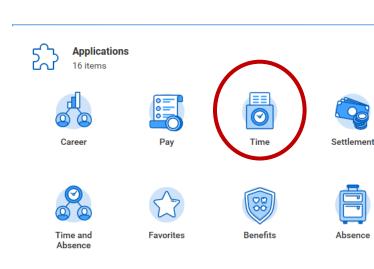




Entering Time Worked

Timeslip Employees

- From the calendar view, click on the start time block and enter information in the pop-up window.
- Utilize the *Time Clock* in Workday for tracking time automatically.
 - ❖NOTE: If using the time clock, you must remember to check out! Check the calendar for an unmatched clock events (checked in but didn't check out). Only your supervisor or myself can correct these.
- Frequency of entry will not change. ALL hours must be submitted and **APPROVED BY SUPERVISOR** at the end of the pay cycle.

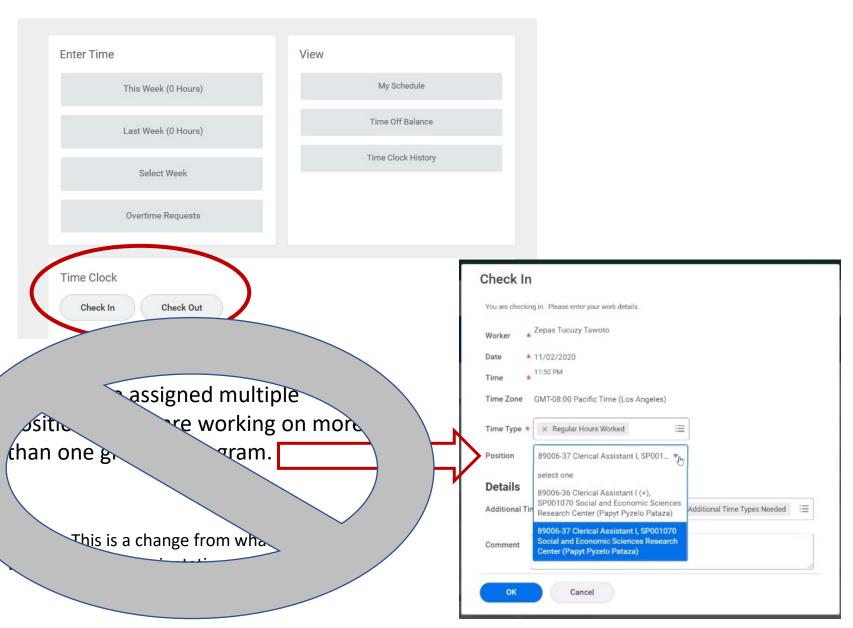
Birthdays

CORRECTION: This will not be how funding identification will occur for timeslip employees. You will only have one position per department. To identify a grant or program (fka budget number) you will indicate this information in the "comments" section. After the time entry occurs, then the costing allocation will be assigned. On a temporary basis, you can put in the 8 digit number from the legacy system and Darla will translate that into the Workday code.

ALL Employees

Status	Description	
Submitted	Time block has been submitted to the Time Approver	Regular Hours Worked 6:00am - 11:00am 5 Hours Submitted
Not Submitted	Time block has been created but not submitted to Time Approver	Regular Hours Worked 8:00am - 12:00pm 4 Hours Not Submitted
Needs Attention	Time block needs attention; usually displayed in cases of unmatched time blocks Oneeds Attention	



Converting Overtime to Comp Time

Overtime Eligible Employees

Just as in the current process, **overtime/comp time** is not earned until you have worked your 40 hours for the week.

- After entering the last block of time where the overtime occurs, under "additional time types for employee selection" you will choose the "convert overtime to compensatory time off" in the drop down then click "ok".
- Comp time will show up under "other" in the top right of your calendar where hours worked and time off hours are shown.



Correct Time Entered

ALL Employees

- From the calendar view, click on the time block. A separate window will open where you can make your corrections.
- Make sure to hit again.
- If already approved, the correction will be rerouted to your supervisor.
- You can also delete time block through the same process but rather than changing the time, you click delete at the bottom of the pop up.

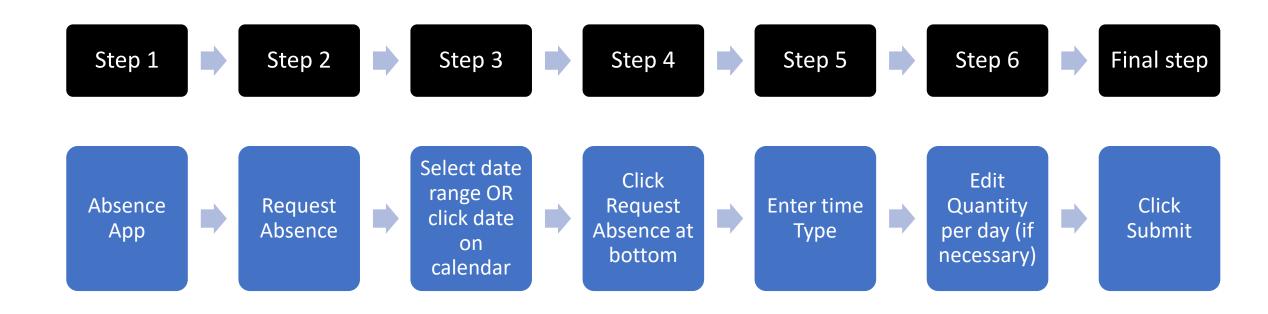


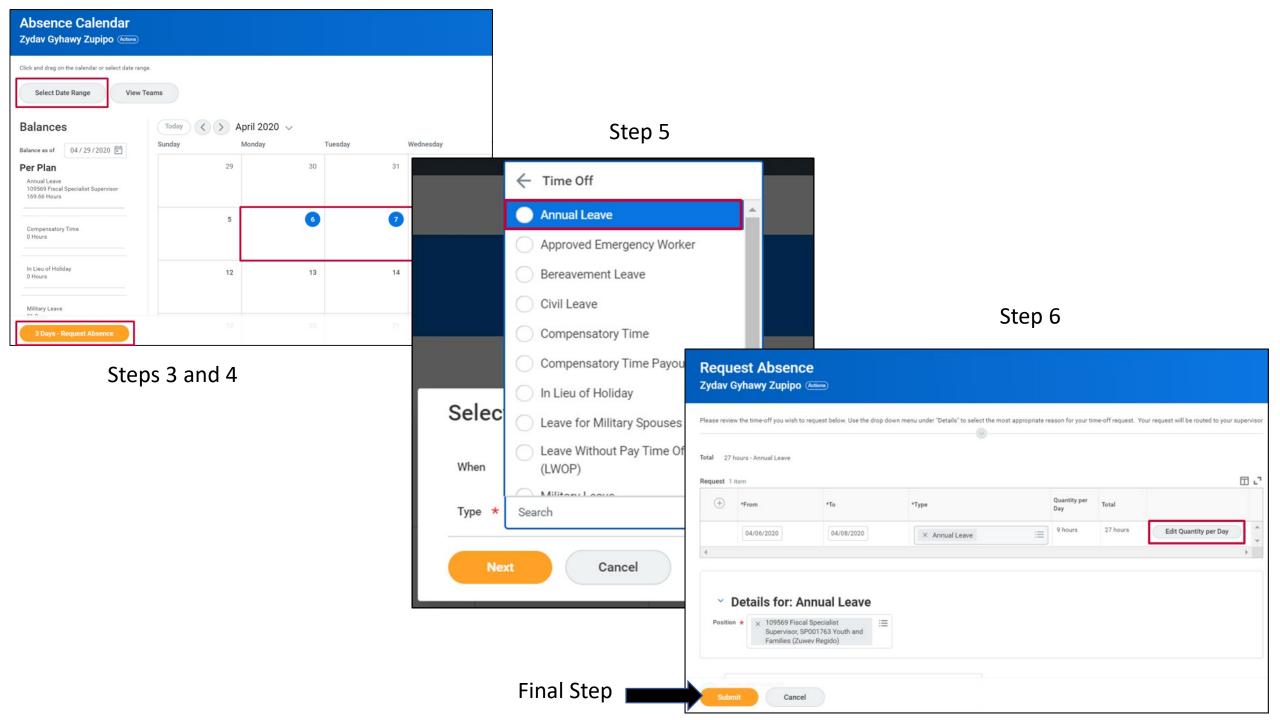
Request Time Off/Absence

ALL Employees

- This process will describe how you will record:
 - ovacation (if applicable)
 - osick leave
 - Personal holiday
 - oleave without pay (LWOP)
 - Other leave.
- It is up to each program whether it will be a requirement for vacation, personal holiday and LWOP to be approved in Workday before taken.
- Absence balances = leave accrual balances.

Request Time Off Absence Steps in Workday







Time Off / Absence

• **Approved** time will be indicated by a green checkmark.



- You can use the *correct time off* feature for past or future dates after the time has been approved. Use the Correct My Absence option. Correcting time will require additional approval.
- You can *cancel* time off only if it has NOT been approved through the Request Absence option. If it has been approved, your supervisor must make the cancellation.



Take Aways

- Overtime eligible employees:
 - Discuss with supervisor about requirement for time off and overtime approvals.
 - Time worked and time off must be entered each pay cycle, at a minimum.

Timeslip

- Cougar Manager will be UNAVAILABLE as of 12/16 so all hours for 1st half of Dec must be entered by 12/15.
- Dec 16 forward, all hours MUST be approved in Workday by supervisor or they will NOT be processed by payroll.

• All

 Time entry in Workday will begin December 16, however, include hours for the entire week. It's ok to duplicate what you have entered on your paper report or in Cougar Manager for Dec 13-15. Workday will only pull the hours for the pay cycle 12/16-12/31 for payroll processing.



Take Aways (cont)

- Time must be entered in blocks.
 Workday does not automatically account for lunch breaks.
- If you have an absence in the middle of the day, you must enter as many blocks as necessary to show time actually worked.
- You must click the button to route to your supervisor for approval.

**Approved time is indicated by a green check mark. Just entering the time on the calendar or using the time clock does not act as the submit function.



Workday Launch Checklist #1

What to do when Workday launches on December 16, 2020:

- ✓ Go to workday.wsu.edu and sign in with your Network ID (NID) and password.
 - NOTE: This link was not working as of 12/4. Keep checking prior to 12/16 for access.
- ✓ Overtime eligible employees: enter your time worked in Workday, starting with the beginning of the week (December 13). It's okay to duplicate what's on your paper time report for December 1-15.
- ✓ Check your time off balances. Something not right? Go to support.workday.wsu.edu, choose "Human Resource Services," and then fill out the form for "Leave Balances or Leave Accrual is incorrect."
- ✓ Review the items listed in the Workday: First 30 Days Employee Guide, especially regarding personal information, payment elections, and tax elections.
