- <u>I.</u> Call to Order The Board of Trustees of School District No. 411, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, met in its regular, properly posted, August board meeting at Canyon Ridge High School boardroom #301 located at 300 North College Road, Twin Falls, Idaho, at the hour of 7:00 p.m., on Monday, September 12, 2022. # VI. Superintendent's Report

A./B. Superintendent Dickinson announced the certified employee of the month from Canyon Ridge High School for the month of September as Scotty Thompson, vice principal and from Twin Falls High School, Jerry Forster, English teacher. Superintendent Dickinson announced the classified employee of the month from Canyon Ridge High School as Alysia Beebe, counseling secretary and from Twin Falls High School as Nancy Barrett, pass room supervisor. Superintendent Dickinson read a brief resume' on each recipient and presented each with a gift, plaque, and gift certificate to Olive Garden.

### VII. Instruction A. Information Item:

- 1. Superintendent Dickinson gave a brief update on enrollment numbers and attendance percentages. Enrollment as of 9-7-2022 is up from 2020, but about the same as this time last year at 9,481. The District expected little-to-no growth this year and budgeted accordingly. The attendance percentages are about back up to normal numbers up over 90%. Pre-pandemic the percentages ran about 92-94%. Funding is based on enrollment numbers again this year. Superintendent Dickinson added that due to another charter school opening next year, we will budget for a slight decrease in enrollment.
- 2. Twin Falls School District Instructional ELL Coach, Khrista Buschhorn and Director of Secondary Programs, L.T. Erickson presented the English Language Learners (ELL) curriculum for consideration of adoption. The committee which was made up of over 50% non-staff, parents and students, after reviewing the pros and cons of the curriculum choices, the committee recommends adoption of the "Reflect" materials through Cengage. Ms. Buschhorn and Dr. Erickson stood for questions from the Board. This is also listed as an action item because it has been presented earlier as a first reading and is time sensitive.
- 3. Teacher, Amanda Hall and Director of Secondary Programs, L.T. Erickson presented curriculum titled, The World of Music. Ms. Hall shared that this curriculum uses a global approach to music in the U.S. and meets the standards. The committee considered all the pros and cons of this curriculum and are recommending it to the Board for approval. This is a first reading and will return for possible board action October 10, 2022.

### VII. Instruction B. Action Item:

1. After some discussion, Vice Chairman Lloyd moved to approve the English Language Learners (ELL) curriculum as recommended by the committee and the secondary director. Trustee Casdorph seconded the motion, motion carried.

The final document has to be finalized and sent in by October 1st.

1. The board finalized the September 28, 2022 board work-session agenda. After a brief discussion, Trustee Casdorph moved to accept the agenda as discussed. Trustee Tubbs seconded the motion, motion carried.
