I. Check-In/Introductions/Time Constraints

II. <u>Interest 3 - Elementary Prep-Time (Cont.)</u>

Handout 2023-2a

Mike Wilkinson shared a handout with the following four (4) bulleted items:

- 1. Use up to 45 minutes on collaboration Monday for data, PD, instructional coaching, best practices as determined by admin.;
- 2. Remaining 45 minutes is team collaboration (Title, SPED, grade level, etc.);
- 3. If admin needs additional time, can exchange for equivalent time next week; and
- 4. No more than 2 mandatory meetings during prep time per month (on Mondays). Interests:
- Student achievement;
- Teacher autotomy;
- Teacher Accountability;
- Use grievance procedure to problem solve; and
- Continue efforts to streamline at elementary levels next year (at breakfast meetings).
 Share minutes from meetings and breakfast meetings. Have Michelle send out to administrators.

The group placed six (6) collaboration items on the board and placed either a 1 or a 2 (or both) for each.

- 1. Instructional calendars (2)
- 2. Examination of data and grade level/and department level (1)
- 3. Common assessments (1&2)
- 4. Lesson plans (2)
- 5. Peer coaching (2)
- 6. Action research on best practices (1)

Consensus was for elementary to use up to 45 minutes on collaboration Monday for data, PD, instructional coaching, best practices as determined by admin.; remaining 45 minute is team collaboration (Title, SPED, grade level, etc.); If admin needs additional time, can exchange for equivalent time next week, and no more than 2 mandatory meetings during prep time per month (on Mondays). If an alternative schedule is run on Monday, teachers will be guaranteed 30 minutes of continuous preparation time in addition to the 45 minutes of collaboration time during early release.

III. <u>Insurance Committee Report</u>

Handout 2023-2b

Peggy Hoy and Rachel Jensen shared the Insurance Committee recommendations and shared some background for the recommendations. It was important to the committee to note that it's not financially responsible to go to the State Insurance plan at a cost of \$4.8 million. Dr. Dickinson added that many districts on state plan contract for custodial and many other classified staff which helps them to afford the state plan. Pocatello and Nampa went to the plan and are struggling with it. The TFSD team did a lot of analysis – if you go to it you're locked in for 5 years.

Committee Recommendations:

- Renewal of the PPO and HSA plan;
- Get a rate cap of 10.9% for 2024/2025 year (if we go with them this year);
- Cannot afford to go to the state plan;
- Stick with Pacific Source:
- HSA;
- Impact on Retirees;
- Talking points;
- Consider an audit of usage; and
- Wellness incentives.

Would cost the District \$4.8 million this year to go to the state plan, and every employee would still be required to pay \$75 per month for insurance. It was also noted that with the state plan employees would have to contact Blue cross directly and not be able to contact Rachel or Rhonda at HUB for assistance on anything. The district would cover the 9.9% increase this year. An idea for next year was shared to do an audit on the usage of the year to analyze.

Consensus was to table this to discuss in the compensation package.

IV. Interest 1 - Compensation Package, Insurance Coverage, and Extra Duty

Handout from yesterday – 2023-1h

Mike Wilkinson stated that the TFEA is willing to accept the compensation package Dr. Dickinson proposed yesterday. The entire group discussed talking points for the ratification meetings.

Consensus was to accept the following:

- Average teacher increase is 15.3% as outlined in the salary schedule (2023-1h);
- \$6359 is added plus your year of experience;
- 5 stipend days;
- 2% COVID stipend- 1% in Oct. and 1% in March;
- 250 PD stipend paid in January;
- \$500,000 set aside for leadership premiums;
- District covers the 9.9% increase in health insurance;
- Recommendation from extra duty committee (4% to the base); and
- Suspension of carryover sharing language due to ESSR funds.

Peggy Hoy commented that they recognize that Brady questions and researches everything, and has the teacher's interest at heart. Also that the entire group has students and teachers

interests at heart. Dr. Dickinson stated that he feels excited for the increases for teachers this year. Administrators are getting a 4% increase, and classified will get \$3 per hour increase.

Calendar Committee Report:

- Calendar was pretty much rolled over from last year;
- Moved February 1st stipend day to last day of Christmas break (Jan. 3rd) so people can have an extra day of Christmas break or have a PD day and get paid.

It was recommended that the calendar committee look at adding the Engage in Education event to the District calendar.

Other notes/comments:

Dr. Dickinson commented that because the SBOE won't meet again until May 22nd, the District will open the 10 positions now.

Next year will be a huge drop in funding because we don't have ESSR funds. So there will need to be adjustments.

Leadership premiums used so far this year is \$164,000. Last year \$300,000 was used between this time last year and the end of the year. So it will be more like \$400,000, like last year.

Consensus on the Calendar as approved by the Board.

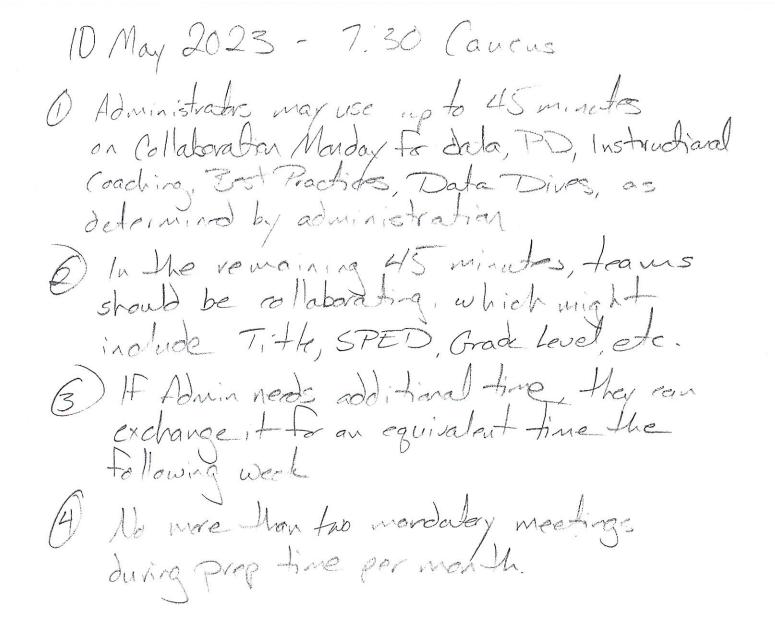
