Pre-Employment Transition Services - ages 14-21 enrolled in education program.

Work Based Learning Experience - building soft skills and hard skills

Started in 2019-20 school year with about a dozen students...

Vocational Rehabilitation Role in the Program

Enrollment in Pre-Employment Transition Services

Coordinate with School District for appropriateness of work experience

Authorize up to 150 hours of reimbursement per student wages and fringe

Educate students / teachers / parents about other VR sponsored activities throughout the year

HIRE Learning (Helping Individuals Reach Employment)

Learning employment and life skills simultaneously.

Served Daily: Hot dogs, homemade waffles, chicken pockets, egg salad, tuna salad and chicken salad sandwiches.

Daily lunch Specials: M- Mac-N-Cheese, T- Tacos, W- Grilled Cheese, Th- Quesadilla, F- Cook's choice.

Daily cleaning chores: dishes, laundry, sweep and mop floors, clean and sanitize tables and stations.

Stock stations, Two times weekly shopping trips, stock and rotate products,

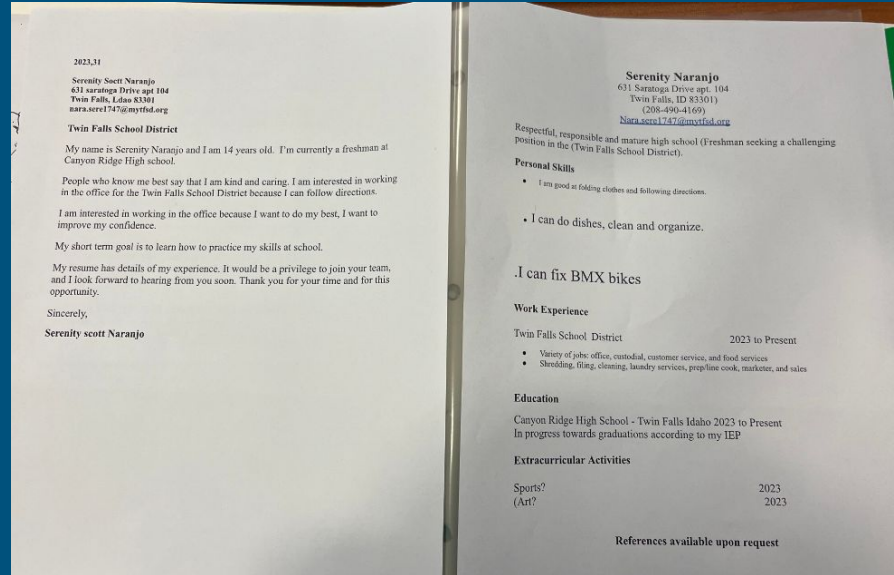
