Cluster of Courses vs Pathway of Courses

Cluster of Courses - Courses a student takes within a career cluster that do not lead to a capstone course, Technical Skills Assessment, college credits, and/or industry certification

Pathway of Courses - A defined pathway of courses within a specified career cluster that lead to a capstone course, Technical Skills Assessment, college credits, and/or industry certification(s)

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

Purpose

Successful career & technical programs maintain close ties with business, industry, and labor and must be integrally linked to the communities and state. Career & technical programs in Idaho are required by IDAPA to “incorporate active input from an appropriately qualified business/industry technical advisory committee.”

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

Technical Advisory Committees should:

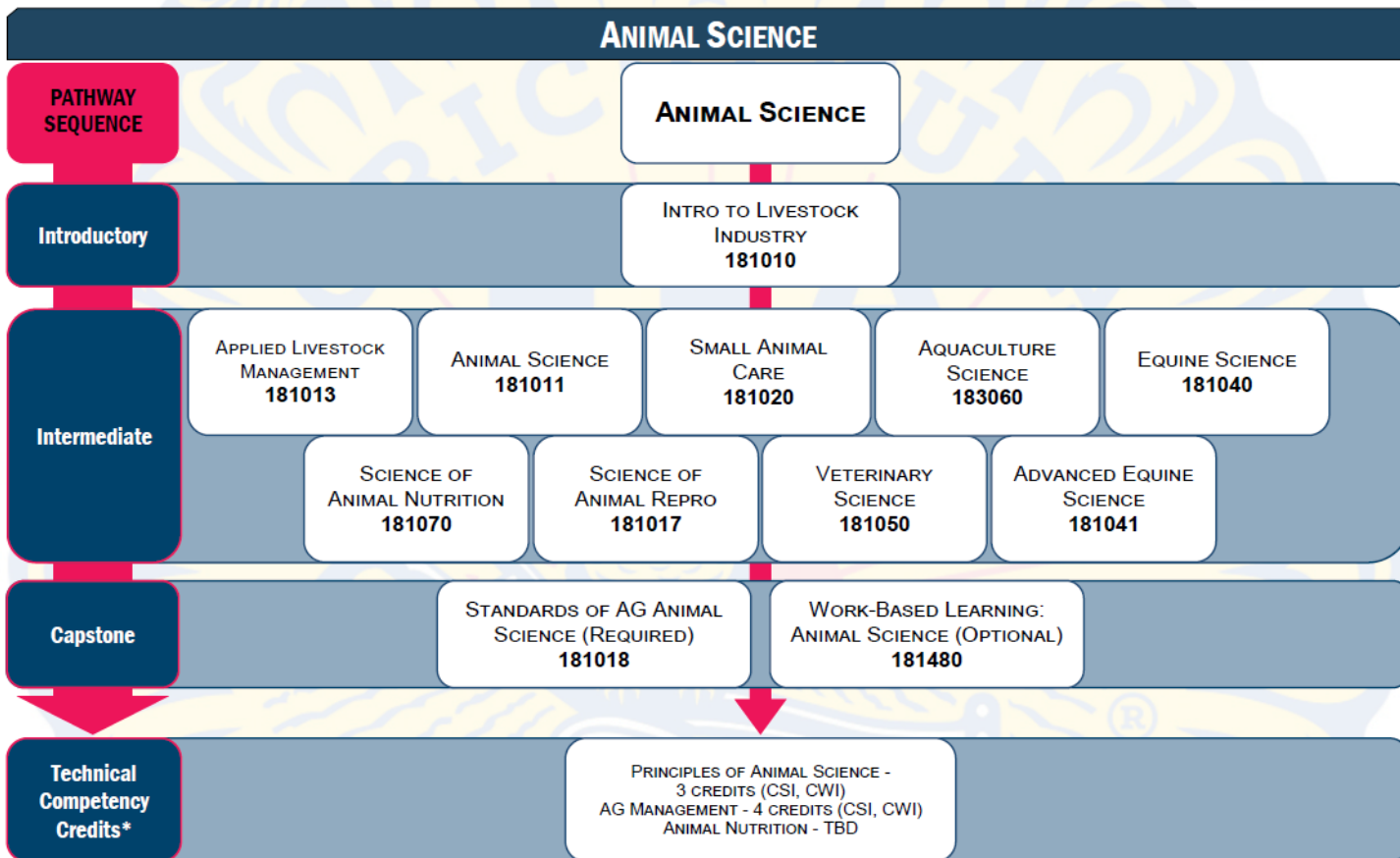
- Bring focus to important program outcomes
- Bring training expertise to the table – they provide on-the-job training to their employees, and can share best practices
- Secure resources for your program – equipment, manpower, expertise
- Provide students and staff with new opportunities – internships, work experiences, career exploration
- Connect you with the larger community – committee members have networks they can engage as appropriate
- Advocate on behalf of your program

Highlights

- **Cameron Hoge's Residential Construction level 3 students received their OSHA 10 certifications.**
- **There are 16 students in the district participating in the CTE CSI UPLINK Program. Some of the classes include: digital media, cabinetry, welding, and diesel tech.**
- **A significant percentage of seniors applied for the Idaho Launch grant (TFHS = 78%, CRHS = 64%, & MVHS = 42%). The state average was 43%.**
- **There is more awareness about the CTE classes at the high schools.**
- **Students at O'Leary, Robert Stuart, South Hills, Canyon Ridge, and Twin Falls earned Adobe and Microsoft Office Certifications.**
