Dear Families,

Lincoln is a Schoolwide Title One School. Our main goals include partnering with parents to help students reach their grade level standards. This year we have an additional goal to allow more access to books and reading material, through grant purchased books, donated books, and electronic options. Studies have shown that the more a student reads, and is read to, the better they do in all subjects in school. Reading at home is a great way to help your student get the extra practice they need to improve this skill. We are encouraging all of our students to read at least 20 minutes per day, or 100 minutes for the week.

In order to support our reading minutes goal, we have added an incentive reading program called "Book It!". This program is sponsored by Pizza Hut and has been in place since 1984. BOOK IT! motivates children to read by rewarding their reading accomplishments with praise, recognition and pizza. The Student Lighthouse Team is working on additional incentives and students will be hearing more about their ideas. This added reading practice time will help your child become a better reader. So far, our students have responded positively and are excited about this new program.

In addition to an incentive program, we want to make sure students stay motivated and have the materials they need if, and when, we move to a modified school schedule. In the event your child does not receive regular library class, we have put together some ideas, and alternative places to get reading material, to continue working towards our reading goals through partnership with you!

We are excited to have received a grant from the Idaho Commision for Libraries which allows us to buy several new books for our library geared towards kindergarten and first grade interest.

The public library is a wonderful resource! Not only do they have books, but they also have ebooks that can be accessed. There is no charge to get a library card if you live in the city limits. For more information, please visit: www.twinfallspubliclibrary.org
