Wonders Reading Program: This week our class will be reading stories about sorting different groups of things in new ways. Children will learn how to sort objects by size, shape, color, weight, or texture. **Vocabulary: sort, similar.** Put a pile of multi-shaped and multi-colored blocks on the floor. Invite your child to sort the blocks by color and by shape. **High-Frequency Word: come, does.** Write the words *come* and *does* on paper. Then have your child write each word. Write sentences using each word. Have your child read the sentences aloud. Ask your child to circle the words *come* and *does*. **Category Words: opposites.** Say a word and ask your child to think of a word with the opposite meaning. **Phonics: long e** Play a rhyming game with your child. Say a word with the long e sound, and have your child think of a rhyming word. For example, encourage your child to say and write words that rhyme with the word *he*, such as *me*, *be*, and *we*. **Comprehension: key details.** Ask your child to draw a line from one object in the left column to a similar object in the right column. **Bridges Math:** Addition and Subtraction! Please practice math facts within 10 at home. Flashcards are a great way to build fluency.
