

What is Title 1?

"Title I" is a federal program that provides funding to local school districts to improve the academic achievement of disadvantaged students. It is part of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act first passed in 1965. That Act is reauthorized by Congress from time to time, and often given a new name. It is currently known as the Every Student Succeeds Act.

Bickel is a Title I school. This means we receive federal funding to help **all** children. Below are just some of the programs and responsibilities of Title 1.

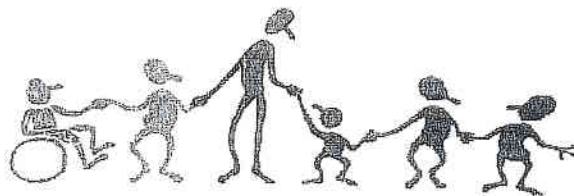
- Small pullout groups for targeted Reading, Language and Math help
