

Greetings Riverhawks!

Welcome back. Registration for the new school year 2020-21 is starting soon. We are living in vastly a different time now compared to last fall, but we are still going to make best of all our opportunities and face all our challenges with positivity. We are still going to make sure Canyon Ridge High School is the most positive high school on the planet. We are in this together and we will make the best of it together.

Safety. For the safety of all involved, there will be changes in the registration process. Please understand that in order to maintain social distancing, everything may take longer. However, we have simplified the process as much as possible to hopefully make registration more efficient and convenient. Only a certain amount of people will be allowed in the building. We discourage bringing younger siblings. Until you are allowed to enter, you must wait outside the front entrance in a line six feet apart. Upon entering and during registration, you must wear a face covering.

Class Schedules. The primary purpose to come to registration is to receive your class schedule and pay fees and exchange important information. It is important that you come on your assigned day. You will not receive your class schedule if you come before your assigned day. Counselors will be available to consider necessary schedule changes. Those requesting necessary schedule changes must wait to see a counselor in the 100 Hall. Because of the unique scheduling constraints of our situation, we cannot promise that all schedule changes will be granted.

Returning Student Online Registration. This must be done before students can receive their class schedule during registration. Most parents completed this in the spring. Many parents have not yet. The process of registration will go much faster if this is done at home before coming to registration. If it can't be done at home, it must be completed here at Canyon Ridge.

Online Flexibility. All our regular classes will provide online flexibility during Orange and Red Levels. Students may also elect to go completely online without face-to-face requirement using Idaho Digital Learning Academy (IDLA). See counselors for more details.

Registration Schedule. All students attending CRHS are required to attend registration in order to pick up a class schedule and pay fees. All students must be accompanied by a parent/guardian at registration to receive a class schedule.

First Day of School. This first day of school will be on August 19. There will be some type of modified schedule in which only a portion of the student body will attend. This will be announced on August 10. We will make this decision when we know the level we will start school with.

Bell Schedule. School will start at 8:05. The first bell will be at 8:00. There will be different schedules depending on the level with which we start school. The school day will end at 3:25.

School Pictures. Pictures for the yearbook will be taken the first week of school on Thursday August 22 and Friday August 23. Parents will have the opportunity to purchase this picture. Senior drape and tux pictures will be taken on August 27 and August 28.

Recommended School Supplies for First Week:
