**Registration will be on a first come first serve basis. 20 spots are available. The age requirement is 14.5 when they go get their permit. The last day to register with IDLA is February 26th at 5 pm. **You will need to get your permit to register for Drivers Education through IDLA. In order to get a permit you will need to pay \$75.00 for the IDLA class and \$180 for the driving portion: The registration fee is \$255 to get your VOC. You will need to pay Mrs. Utley at the bookkeeping office to get a VOC. **Once you have your VOC (verification of compliance) you will need to get your permit from the DMV. **Once your student has their permit and is registered for IDLA, they will need to do the "Orientation" it is very important that they complete this as soon as possible. (If your student has already done "Orientation from previous IDLA classes-they will not need to do it again) **If the Orientation is not completed and the class starts, they will be dropped from the class. Driving times will be scheduled with Keith Meitzner at Canyon Ridge. All drives will originate at Canyon Ridge High School in the alley behind the school. Please contact Mrs. Utley, or Mr. Lavin with any questions... Drivers Education requires a passing grade of 80% or better.
