This time will also provide extra tutoring time for students who need it. We are also returning to one lunch for all students as well. There will be seven periods as always. The advisory period will come after second period. The one lunch will come after fourth period.

Registration: Student registration will take place **August 3rd, 4th, & 5th**. All students attending CRHS are required to attend registration in order to pick up a class schedule and pay fees. **All students should be accompanied by a parent/guardian** for registration and/or schedule changes.

Pre-registration should be filled out in advance online at tfsd.org (recommended to speed up process). If you have not updated your online registration for the 2021-22 school year, please do so prior to registration (this should have been completed last spring, so you may already have it completed). Computers will be available for those who have not completed it, however your student can not start the registration process until Parent/guardian have completed the online registration. Students will **not** be given the login information. This is for the parents only.

- **Freshmen (ALL): Thursday, Aug. 5th**, 8:00 AM-12:30 PM & 3:30-6:00 PM (doors will lock at 12:00pm & 5:30pm).
- **Open Office Hours: Friday August 6th**, 8:00 AM -12:00 pm (doors lock @ 11:30). Anyone who missed their scheduled day can register during this session, however please understand that registration during this session will possibly take longer, so please try to attend the appropriate session for your grade listed above.
