Each high school has a Driver Education class-Face2Face.

FACE2FACE: Students may register (signup list) in the bookkeeping office during the registration dates posted above. Students are selected chronologically by birthdates. We decide how many students are needed to fill the session and then invite students and parents to a meeting to explain how to obtain a permit and pay the fee. **The cost is \$180** for the class and a fee of \$26.50 to purchase the permit. Students must have a certified copy of birth certificate with the stamped seal on it to purchase the permit. Be sure you have this birth certificate before you sign up. NO photocopies of the birth certificate are allowed. Students must be at least 14 ½ years of age and have a 2.0 G.P.A. to enroll in class. **Students that are not selected for a session must sign up again for the next session to be considered. We do not carry student's names over to the next session.**

Students will be charged a missed drive fee of \$50.00 for missing a scheduled drive.

Driving times are scheduled by the instructor, usually after school and on the weekends.

Students are allowed only 2 absences, 3 tardies (equal one absence). Students are graded on the classroom, driving and attitude. Students must pass all 3 areas to pass the course.

Canyon Ridge High School runs their classes from 6:45-7:45 a.m. 5 days a week for 7 weeks. Classes are held in room 302.

Class starting dates are subject to change based on School Calendar events and instructor availability. Signup up dates are subject to change as affected by changes in the calendar.

HOW ONLINE REGISTRATION WORKS...

- 1. Students will be required to pay \$255.00 (\$75.00 fee for IDLA (this is the classroom instruction) and \$180.00 for the driving portion) of the class at the bookkeeping office. THIS NEEDS TO BE DONE FIRST.
- 2. After paying, this will insure a spot and their name will be on the list for the ONLINE CLASS.
- 3. The student will then receive an Authorization form to the DMV and Verification of Compliance form in order to purchase a Driver Training Permit. <u>Cost for permit is \$26.50.</u> And information on how to log into IDLA to register for the class.
- 4. Students must have a certified copy of birth certificate with the stamped seal on it to purchase the permit. Be sure you have this birth certificate before you sign up. NO photocopies of the birth certificate are allowed. Students must be at least $14\frac{1}{2}$ years of age.
- 5. Driving times are scheduled by the instructor, usually after school and on the weekends.
