
Senior Project Timeline- Senior Year

- September
 - Senior Project Check-in – advisors check with each student to see how much project progress was made over summer. Checklist with senior project requirements on Google Classroom. Make sure seniors have all proposal papers and poster of commitment in portfolio.
 - New seniors – have project approved by senior advisor
 - Seniors who did not go through boards last spring – must go through Jr. Boards
 - Any revisions needing to be made must be approved by advisor.
 - First journal check. If project has not started yet, this first journal check grade will occur when student starts project.
- October
 - Research paper due in English 12
 - Journal check #2
 - Self-reflection shared with parent at Student Led Conferences
- November
 - Journal check #3
 - Mid-project mentor evaluation due
- December
 - Journal check #4
 - Graded copy of research paper in portfolio
- January
 - Journal check #5

- February – Remaining portfolio documents are due
 - Complete journal with signatures (5 parent/5 mentor)
 - Final mentor evaluation
 - Self-evaluation
 - Table of contents in portfolio
 - March is a big month for senior projects! **Complete portfolio and tri-fold boards are turned into the advisor by February 28** – this gives the advisor time to go through each project to make sure students have met all of the requirements.
 - **February 28** – Portfolio is due, it will include a table of contents, journal (w/ five mentor and parent signatures), two mentor evaluations, a self-evaluation, and a graded copy of the research paper. Any extra photos, paperwork, etc. may go in the portfolio as well.
 - **February 28** - Tri-fold board is due. This is a visual representation of the senior project – both the physical and written components.
 - Examples of complete portfolios and tri-fold boards are in the library and photos are on the Google Classroom.
 - A complete portfolio and tri-fold must be approved by the advisor before Open House and Senior Boards – students with incomplete projects may not participate in Open House or Boards!!

- March
 - **March 16 - Open House** – participation is mandatory, in the Baun Gym, 4-6 pm. Members of the community are invited to view senior projects – this gives students a chance to talk about their project and get ready for senior boards.

- **March 19- Senior Boards** – participation is mandatory, at assigned times throughout the day. The rubric that is used to assess students is in the Senior Project Guidelines.

A complete portfolio and tri-fold must be approved by the advisor before Open House and Senior Boards – students with incomplete projects may not participate in Open House or Boards!!

- April
 - Send thank you note to mentor and anyone else who helped student throughout the project.
