Senior Trip Permission Form

- All students attending the Senior Trip must not have drugs or alcohol in their possession nor be under the influence of drugs or alcohol. There will be thorough bag checks and student screenings before students board the buses, at the California border, and at Disneyland Grad Nite.

- All district policies will be enforced on this trip.
