# RSMS 30 Minute Reading Block

At RSMS we value literacy and feel that it is important for all students to read every day.

## Teacher Reminder

AR is an accountability measure but the value is in students reading 30 minutes every day. Even if a student has reached his/her goal he/she should continue to read.

## Teacher Procedures

- 30 Minute Reading Block is done for the first 30 minutes of SSC each day.
- Students may only leave the room to visit the library for new reading material or to consult with the librarian. Only 1 student goes from a class at a time.
- Students may not work on outside classwork at this time.
- Teachers should not allow students to read books below reading level (create ZPD guide)
- Reading Log

## Grading Procedures

- 25% grade (AR Points)
- 25% grade (Silent Sustained Reading)

## Rules

- All literature is available. Points can be added via a consultation with the teacher or librarian.
- Only SSC teacher or ELA teacher can give tests.
- Tests are done through personal discussion, official AR test, written summary.
- Reading log required at time of test
- Exception: On the event that a student may be reading a long book a teacher may use discretion to assess the length of the book and award points through the process of the book to prevent the student from having a negative grade consequence.

# RSMS 30 Minute Study Hall

At RSMS it is important to allow students more time during the day to work with teachers.

## Teacher Procedures

- This is done for the second 30 minutes of SSC each day.
- Teacher is to guide students to work on the class with the lowest grade.
- Once a week the student must demonstrate a system of organization to teacher.

## Rules

- Students may only leave the room with a signed permission slip from a teacher. (see pass)

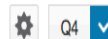
