Parent voice refers to the values, opinions, beliefs, perspectives, and backgrounds of the parents, guardians, and families of students enrolled in school. Parent focus groups are a guided open forum for parents to constructively discuss ways that they can support the school and the school can support parents and students. It is collaborative effort between the school and parents where parents are actively encouraged to offer suggestions, share ideas, and assist with school improvement strategies. Parent focus groups are not for specific personal complaints, these are best addressed to a relevant staff member or school administration.

- Improve communications between the school and parent/community

- To promote partnership between parents and school staff.
- To work with parents and the school to support the education and welfare of children.
