P.A.W.S. FOCUS- PRIDE IN THE HALLWAY

Last week, there were a few disruptions in the hallway, especially when students were heading to the auditorium for Primetime and we would like to review our expectations for all when traveling from one place to another in the school:

PRIDE-Take care of belongings, keep it clean

ATTITUDE-Be aware of others' space, Keep hands to yourself

WISE CHOICES-Keep moving, arrive on time, enter learning area quiet and prepared

SAFETY-Travel on the right, walk, don't run, wait against the wall before entering class

Voice level is also from 0-2, depending on when students are in the hallway. When it's during passing time, 0-2 is appropriate. However, when other students are in class (passing time at lunch, going to auditorium, etc.), voice level should **always** be at a 0.
