P.A.W.S. FOCUS- CREDIT RECOVERY

We are in the last week of first quarter already! At this point, we are working on making sure all students have a chance to be successful and will be implementing Credit Recovery starting October 30th. The following is information for students to know about the process:

What is Credit Recovery? Credit Recovery is a program that gives students a chance to work on and turn in missing work in order to get back on track with their grades.

Why do we have Credit Recovery? In order to matriculate to the next grade level, a student **MUST** receive at least 12 of the 14 credits, or 80% of the credits. It is also important to make sure all material is completed from your teacher each quarter as the lessons in class build on each other. It's hard to move forward when pieces are still missing from the previous quarter!

When is Credit Recovery? Credit Recovery will begin the following quarter and continue every Tuesday and Thursday from 7:30 to 8:30 am. The first session for second quarter will be on October 30th. The location you will be assigned to will be communicated the day before it starts.

What does the blue paper mean? If you receive a blue paper today, or anytime between now and the end of the quarter, it means you are **AT RISK** of being enrolled in Credit Recovery if you do not improve your grades by October 19th. This process will happen again at the end of each quarter, so keep an eye on your progress!

If you are able to retrieve all credits by the 19th, you will automatically be removed from the list and **WILL NOT** need to turn in the form.

If you are not able to retrieve all credits by the 19th, you will need to turn the form in no later than October 24th.
