P.A.W.S. FOCUS- WISE CHOICES WITH CONFRONTATIONS AND FRIENDS

This week we would like for you to talk to the students about expectations when confronted by somebody as well as an assessment on what being a friend means. We would like ALL students to know that there is no tolerance for fighting on campus. Any student who is involved in any contact or instigating others to fight will have to follow up with consequences. Also, defending one's self does not mean fighting back. It consists of the following:

- Leaving the situation
- Reporting to an administrator
- Walking away
- Ignoring any negative comments made rather than engaging in the behavior

Feel free to have any other conversations with your students that you would like about proper respect and attitude on campus.

There have also been a few situations brought to the office with peers not being respectful to one another, but they are still labeled as a "friend". Discuss what a friend entails and what qualities students want in a friend. It is so important for us to see our students model the respectful behavior that they would like in return and we appreciate you taking the time to discuss this with them.
