P.A.W.S. FOCUS- PERSONAL BELONGINGS

We would like to take some time to review expectations for personal belongings:

- Backpacks-All students are allowed to bring a backpack to and from school to carry books, etc. Once at school, students need to leave the backpack in their lockers from before 1st period until after 7th period. Having backpacks in the already full classrooms is a tripping hazard and we need to make sure all students and staff are in a safe environment. The same is true if they are left in the hallway during class time.
- Water Bottles-Students are allowed to carry water bottles with them during the day. The
 water bottles need to be clear and the only liquid allowed in them is water. Any colored
 drinks, such as coffee or energy drinks is a risk for stains in the classroom if it is spilled.
 Some classrooms have new carpet and we would like to keep all rooms as nice as
 possible throughout the year.
- Lockers-Students, please make sure your lock is secure after you use your locker every time. We are not responsible for lost items. It is important to take care of your belongings and that includes securing them in a safe place. Also, do not give out your combination to others. You and the office should be the only ones who know how to get into your locker so there is no possibility of theft.
- Hats/Hoodies-Wearing hats or the hood of a sweatshirt while in the building is a dress code violation. Wearing either of these inside of any building is disrespectful. Please make sure you follow expectations as a violation of this is:1st-warning, 2nd-parent contact, 3rd-PASS room.
- Electronics-Please respect teacher policies within each classroom. They must be turned off and out of sight unless the teacher authorizes the use specifically. We are also not responsible for the device if you choose to bring it to school.
