

Dear Parent/Guardian,

At Google, we believe in the power of imagination and how it can change the world. This year's Doodle for Google theme is "I care for myself by..." and invites your child(ren) to open up their creative hearts and show us all the ways they nurture their bodies, minds and spirits. What are their favorite things to do that make them feel better when they're feeling down? How do they take a break? What activities make them feel calm or give them energy? What or who brings joy to their heart? It's up to your students how they interpret the theme, where they take it artistically, and what materials they use to create their unique doodle.

The contest opens **January 11, 2022** and goes through **March 4, 2022. 54 students** will be named winners from their state/territory. Four finalists will win a **\$5,000** scholarship and one winning student will receive:

- A \$30,000 college scholarship
- · A \$50,000 Google for Education technology package for their school
- · Their artwork will be placed on the Google homepage for a day

How to Enter

- 1. Download the entry form at doodle4google.com.
- 2. Have students create their Doodle using any material they want (paint, pencils, crayons, markers, chalk, pastels, charcoal, cray-pas, collage, and digital graphics). Students can draw their Doodle on the entry form, a separate sheet of paper, or a computer. If they do not draw on the entry form, make sure the completed artwork is taped to it.
- 3. Have students write their 50-word descriptive statement on their entry form.
- 4. Make sure you sign your student's form.
- 5. Submit your students' completed entry forms digitally (preferred) or by mail.

For Digital Entries: Visit doodle4google.com to upload multiple entries at once (.jpg or .png).

For Mail-in Entries: Mailed submissions must be postmarked by March 4, 2022. Use the postmarked return envelope in your kit (or any standard-sized envelope) and address it to:

How to enter your Doodle



We're excited to see the amazing doodles for the 2022 Doodle for Google theme, "I care for myself by..." Follow these helpful instructions to make sure your Doodle makes it into the contest.



Step 1: Print and fill out the form

Print out and complete each field on the form. To be accepted, all entries need your school info, a title and description, and most importantly, a signature from your parent/quardian.



Step 2: Add your doodle

Create your Doodle. You can create directly on the form or on a separate sheet of paper, using any materials you want. Keep in mind that you will later need to attach it to the form with glue or clear tape.

If you are creating your Doodle with other materials, you will need to take a high-res photo of your art, print it and attach it.



Be sure your Doodle art or photo fits exactly in the space outlined on the form

Step 3: Submit the form

Now get your masterpiece to us! The contest is open for entries until March 4, 2022, 9pm PT.

Online (Recommended): Scan/photograph your completed form and enter it at doodles.google.com/d4g/enter/. If you're submitting via photo, take a high res photo in good lighting. Note that the file format must be .png or .jpeg.

By Mail: Scan and print out your completed form. Send your entry to:
