GOOGLE COMPUTER SCIENCE EDUCATION IN MEDIA SCREENWRITING FELLOWSHIP (“FELLOWSHIP”)

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Google Computer Science Education in Media Screenwriting Fellowship Submission Call (the “Submission Call”), hosted by the Black List, LLC, is subject to the following requirements:

- The candidate must post a feature length script or teleplay on www.blcklst.com for at least one week during the Submission Period and opt in to the Submission Call.
- Such script must be original to the candidate.
- If the script is written by a team consisting of one or more writers, each member of that writing team must comply with these Submission Requirements. In the event that a team of one or more writers is selected for the Fellowship, such team will split equally the \$15,000 fellowship grant.
- The candidate must be competent to contract and over the age of 18.
- The candidate must agree to these Submission Requirements as well as the Submission Agreement, which governs the submission of the candidate’s script to Company. While the candidate retains ownership of the script, **the Submission Agreement includes important terms and conditions (including arbitration of disputes) you should read before accepting.**
- If selected by Company for the Fellowship the candidate must: Six months following the start of the Fellowship, provide a designated representative of Company with a sample of his/her new work, which must include a focus on changing the image in popular culture of computer science and computer scientists, along with a report addressing how the Fellowship has been used to advance his/her work and/or career.
- If requested, the candidate must submit the following, which are also governed by the Submission Agreement:
 - a one-page biography;
 - contact and other personal information; and
 - signed originals of the Submission Agreement

Please note, Company reserves the right to grant no Fellowship if, in the opinion of Company, no entry is of sufficient merit.
