SCRIPTURE VERSES FOR EACH DAY OF COUNTING THE OMER

Suggestions for using this booklet:

- 1) Read the day's verse(s) in connection with counting the omer and use the check box to mark your progress.
- 2) Find one principle and its life-application from the daily verse(s).
- 3) Choose one of the verses each week to memorize.
- 4) If you are able, read the verse(s) in their original Hebrew or Greek as practice in your Hebrew or Greek studies, and for further study.
- 5) At least one verse has been selected from each of the 66 books in the Bible. Consider what verse or verses you might have chosen.

Day One The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes, And to him shall be the obedience of the peoples. Genesis 49:10
Day Two They shall know that I am the LORD their God who brought them out of the land of Egypt, that I might dwell among them; I am the LORD their God. Exodus 29:46
Day Three For I am the LORD who brought you up from the land of Egypt to be your God; thus you shall be holy, for I am holy. Leviticus 11:45
Day Four You shall not defile the land in which you live, in the midst of which I dwell; for I the LORD am dwelling in the midst of the sons of Israel. Numbers 35:34
Day Five The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your countrymen, you shall listen to him. Deuteronomy 18:15
Day Six This book of the Torah shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success. Joshua 1:8
Day Seven Hear, O kings; give ear, O rulers! I, I will sing to the LORD, I will sing, I will sing praise to the LORD, the God of Israel. Judges 5:3

Day Eight May the LORD reward your work, and your wages be full from the LORD, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to seek refuge. Ruth 2:12
<i>Day Nine</i> Speak, LORD, for Your servant is listening. 1Samuel 3:9 Now, O Lord GOD, You are God, and Your words are truth, and You have promised this good thing to Your servant. 2Samuel 7:28
Day Ten Blessed be the LORD, who has given rest to His people Israel, according to all that He promised; not one word has failed of all His good promise, which He promised through Moses His servant. 1Kings 8:56 But the LORD, who brought you up from the land of Egypt with great power and with an outstretched arm, Him you shall fear, and to Him you shall bow yourselves down, and to Him you shall sacrifice. 2Kings 17:36
Day Eleven For David said, "The LORD God of Israel has given rest to His people, and He dwells in Jerusalem forever. 1Chronicles 23:25 He said, "O LORD, the God of Israel, there is no god like You in heaven or on earth, keeping covenant and showing lovingkindness to Your servants who walk before You with all their heart;" 2Chronicles 6:14
Day Twelve And they observed the Feast of Unleavened Bread seven days with joy, for the LORD had caused them to rejoice, and had turned the heart of the king of Assyria toward them to encourage them in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel. Ezra 6:22

Day Thirteen You, in Your great compassion, did not forsake them in the wilderness; the pillar of cloud did not leave them by day, to guide them on their way, nor the pillar of fire by night, to light for them the way in which they were to go. You gave Your good Spirit to instruct them, your manna You did not withhold from their mouth, and You gave them water for their thirst. Nehemiah 9:19–20
Day Fourteen For the Jews there was light and gladness and joy and honor. Esther 8:16
Day Fifteen As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, and at the last He will take His stand on the earth. Job 19:25
Day Sixteen Teach me to do Your will, for You are my God; Let Your good Spirit lead me on level ground. Psalm 143:10
Day Seventeen Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5–6
Day Eighteen The conclusion, when all has been heard, is: fear God and keep His commandments, because this applies to every person. Ecclesiastes 12:13 I am my beloved's and my beloved is mine. Canticles 6:3
Day Nineteen I am the LORD, I have called you in righteousness, I will also hold you by the hand and watch over you, and I will appoint you as a covenant to the people, as a light to the nations Isaiah 42:6

Day Twenty Behold, the days are coming," declares the LORD, when I will raise up for David a righteous Branch; and He will reign as king and act wisely and do justice and righteousness in the land. In His days Judah will be saved, and Israel will dwell securely; and this is His name by which He will be called, "The LORD our righteousness." Jeremiah 23:5–6
Day Twenty-one The LORD'S lovingkindnesses indeed never cease, for His compassions never fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness. Lamentations 3:22–23
Day Twenty-two I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances. Ezekiel 36:27
Day Twenty-three For His dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His kingdom endures from generation to generation. All the inhabitants of the earth are accounted as nothing, but He does according to His will in the host of heaven and among the inhabitants of earth; and no one can ward off His hand or say to Him, "What have You done?" Daniel 4:34–35
Day Twenty-four I will betroth you to Me forever; yes, I will betroth you to Me in righteousness and in justice, in lovingkindness and in compassion, and I will betroth you to Me in faithfulness. Then you will know the LORD. Hosea 2:19–20
Day Twenty-five And it will come about that whoever calls on the name of the LORD will be delivered. Joel 2:32

Day Twenty-six In that day I will raise up the fallen booth of David, and wall up its breaches; I will also raise up its ruins and rebuild it as in the days of old; that they may possess the remnant of Edom and all the nations who are called by My name, declares the LORD who does this. Amos 9:11–12
Day Twenty-seven But on Mount Zion there will be those who escape, and it will be holy. And the house of Jacob will possess their possessions. Obadiah 17
Day Twenty-eight But I will sacrifice to You with the voice of thanksgiving. That which I have vowed I will pay. Salvation is from the LORD. Jonah 2:9
Day Twenty-nine He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8
Day Thirty The LORD is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble, and He knows those who take refuge in Him. Nahum 1:7
Day Thirty-one Though the fig tree should not blossom and there be no fruit on the vines, though the yield of the olive should fail and the fields produce no food, though the flock should be cut off from the fold and there be no cattle in the stalls, yet I will exult in the LORD, I will rejoice in the God of my salvation. Habakkuk 3:17–18
Day Thirty-two The LORD your God is in your midst, a victorious warrior. He will exult over you with joy, He will be quiet in His love, He will rejoice over you with shouts of joy. Zeph 3:17

Day Thirty-three As for the promise which I made you when you came out of Egypt, My Spirit is abiding in your midst; do not fear!' Haggai 2:5
Day Thirty-four Many nations will join themselves to the LORD in that day and will become My people. Then I will dwell in your midst, and you will know that the LORD of hosts has sent Me to you. Zechariah 2:11
Day Thirty-five Behold, I am going to send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and terrible day of the LORD. He will restore the hearts of the fathers to their children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, so that I will not come and smite the land with a curse. Malachi 4:5–6
Day Thirty-six As for me, I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, and I am not fit to remove His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. Matthew 3:11 I baptized you with water; but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit. Mark 1:8 And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high. Luke 24:49
Day Thirty-seven But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful. John 14:26–27

Day Thirty-eight but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusa- lem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remot- est part of the earth. Acts 1:8
Day Thirty-nine Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect. Romans 12:1–2
Day Forty For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. 1Corinthians 12:13 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 2Corinthians 3:17
Day Forty-one Because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" Galatians 4:6
Day Forty-twothat He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man. Ephesians 3:16 For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Messiah Yeshua. Philippians 1:6 Therefore as you have received Messiah Yeshua the Lord, so walk in Him, having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude. Colosians 2:6–7

Day Forty-three For this reason we also constantly thank God that when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you accepted it not as the word of men, but for what it really is, the word of God, which also performs its work in you who believe. 1Thessalonians 2:13 But we should always give thanks to God for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth. 2Thessalonians 2:13
Day Forty-four For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Messiah Yeshua, who gave Himself as a ransom for all, the testimony given at the proper time. 1Timothy 2:5–6 Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth. 2Timothy 2:15 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Messiah Yeshua, who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds. Titus 2:13–14
Day Forty-five and I pray that the fellowship of your faith may become effective through the knowledge of every good thing which is in you for Messiah's sake. Philemon 6
Day Forty-six Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, fixing our eyes on Yeshua, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1–2

Day Forty-seven But one who looks intently at the perfect Torah, the Torah of liberty, and abides by it, not having become a forgetful hearer but an effectual doer, this man will be blessed in what he does. James 1:25
Day Forty-eight The one who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. We know by this that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us. 1John 3:24 And this is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, just as you have heard from the beginning, that you should walk in it. 2John 6 Beloved, do not imitate what is evil, but what is good. The one who does good is of God; the one who does evil has not seen God. 3John 11
Day Forty-nine Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to make you stand in the presence of His glory blameless with great joy, to the only God our Savior, through Yeshua Messiah our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion and authority, before all time and now and forever.
