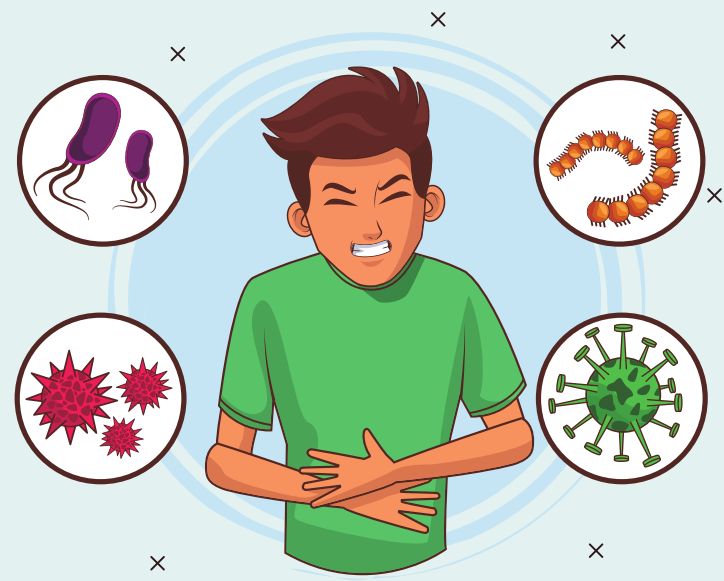


Travel Guidance During COVID-19

Travel increases your chance of getting and spreading COVID-19.

Do not travel:

- With someone who is sick
- If you are sick
- If you have been around someone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days



Before you travel:

(Based on CDC Website)

- Check to see if COVID-19 spreading at your destination
- Check requirements or restrictions for travelers to your destination
- Check state, territorial, tribal and local public health websites for information before you travel



If you must travel:

- Wear mask(s) during travel
- Avoid close contact by staying at least 6 feet apart from others
- Wash your hands or use sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth



During travel:

- Avoid close contact in drop-off/pick-up zones, security lines, check-in areas and airport terminals
- Have all travel documents and identification protected and secured



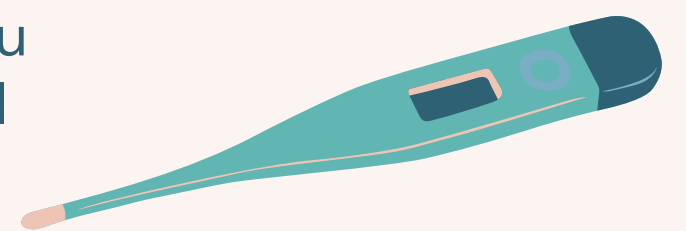
Avoid high risk activities:

- Destinations with High Level 3 Travel Health Notice
- Large social gatherings (weddings, funerals, parties, etc.)
- Mass gatherings (sports events, concerts, parades, etc.)
- Being in crowds (restaurants, bars, movie theaters, cruise ships, etc.)



Check your temperature:

- Keep a thermometer with you at all times during your travel
- Check your temperature at least two times a day
