SUBJECT: Early Re-entry for Brazoria County Cattle Producers

To apply for Early Re-entry status following a catastrophic disaster in Brazoria County please fill out **both sides** of the enclosed application and return it to my assistant, Jean Godwin, at the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Office, Brazoria County, 21017 CR 171, Angleton, TX 77515. I will review the application, and if accepted, your re-entry letter will be mail to you.

Please be aware, if you choose to stay or re-enter early, you should carry your Early Re-entry Letter with you to avoid any unnecessary delays. Keep in mind, if you encounter any problems with the letter during a natural disaster, you can contact the Agriculture and Natural Resources Desk at the Emergency Operations Command (EOC) at 979-864-1411. Please note, you must have a valid Driver's license or Texas ID to receive a letter. Letters are not issued to minors without an ID. If you choose to bring minors into a disaster area, you *may or may not* be allowed past the checkpoint. It will be left to the discretion of the officer operating the checkpoint. Please note, you are held responsible for the safety of all persons whose letters are issued under your name/business.

I have enclosed a pamphlet, *Livestock Hurricane Preparedness Guide*, which includes information on our point-to-point contact with Bell County, Texas for the evacuation of high value livestock from Brazoria County. Please share this livestock shelter information with anyone you know who may be evacuating horses, youth livestock projects, high value breeding stock, etc. Bell County has proven to be a gracious host during past hurricanes, as they also serve as our evacuation location for residents with special needs.
