## **EVACUATION ORDER**

In the City of Rosenberg August 26, 2017

Due to flooding and the potential for flooding, the City of Rosenberg has issued a mandatory evacuation order for residents and visitors in the following areas of Rosenberg, Texas:

- West Street and Mulcahy Street: North of Avenue D.
- River Road area: All properties North of River Road, adjacent to the river.
- North of Brazos: All properties North of the Brazos River, within the City limits.
- North Rosenberg: All properties East of 4<sup>th</sup> Street, North of Avenue B; all properties on 1<sup>st</sup> Street North of Avenue D.

The evacuation shall be effective as of 2:00 p.m., August 26, 2017. After 2:00 p.m., Saturday, August 26, 2017, no access will be allowed to the area as referenced above.

All residents and visitors in the designated areas, are advised to evacuate as expediently as possible before the effects of Brazos River flooding begin to bring high, rapidly moving, water to the area as referenced above.

A Declaration of Disaster has been issued for the City of Rosenberg.

It is imperative that you follow the directions of local law enforcement.

Evacuating as recommended will help avoid traffic backups and congestion that may prolong evacuation and will help to ensure your safety in the face of rising flood waters.
