### **Overview**

## **About this plan**

This plan was developed in an effort to prevent Coronavirus ("COVID-19") infection, as a result of a pandemic in 2020. This documents follows industry guidance for offices, issued by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) and Cal/OSHA on 05/12/20. This plan applies to staff in the Training & Education department (a.k.a., Risk & Safety Training).

#### Worksite characteristics

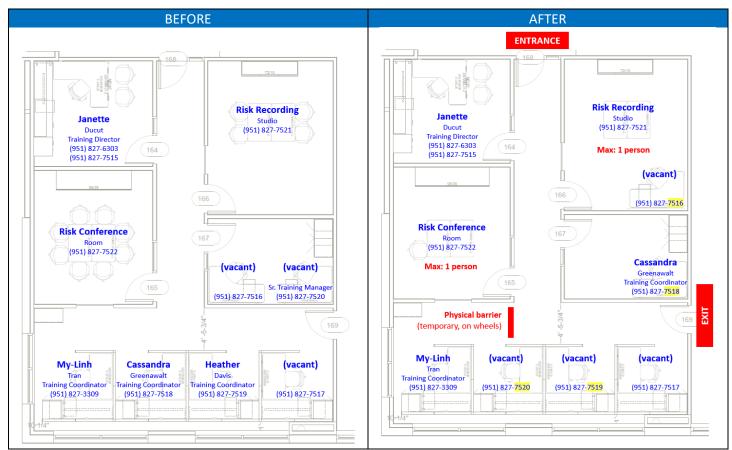


Figure 1. Layout of UCPath Risk Services suite.

Training & Education staff report to the UC Intellicenter building ("UCPath"), and are enclosed within the "Risk Services" suite. This area is secured by a keypad only known to occupants. There are two doors used to access the space. Common areas (e.g., break room, restrooms, etc.) are maintained outside of the space. The before- and after- changes are summarized in Figure 1.

## **Responsible Party**

The individual responsible for implementation is Janette de la Rosa Ducut.

Designate one door for entry, and another for exit. Discontinue group use of Conference Room and Recording Studio. Relocate staff to separate offices / spaces. Place physical barrier in cubicle area to separate staff from foot traffic. Move EH&S Training Coordinator to EH&S building.

## Risk assessment

The location-specific risks and controls are outlined in this section. Details involving schedules and daily standard operating procedures are indicated as well, which provide additional administrative controls. Staff will adhere to all prevention controls outlined in this section.

## **LOCATIONS**

Entrance/exit and hallways	Common corridor. Staff may run into each other during entry/exit	<ul> <li>Doors. Designate entrance and exit doors. Door with keypad (North entrance) to be used only for entrance. Door on (South-East) to be used only for exit, and to remain locked during business hours.</li> <li>Face coverings. Wear face coverings during entry/exit, and when moving outside of the cubicle, office, conference, or recording room spaces.</li> <li>Schedule &amp; Telecommuting. Restrict work hours onsite based on an alternating days/time schedule. The remaining days will be conducted via telecommuting.</li> <li>Visitors. Restrict use of space only to occupants (no visitors allowed).</li> <li>Signage. Install signs and floor markings indicating entrance, exit, and when face coverings must be used.</li> </ul>
Office	<ul> <li>Risk Manager. Training Director's office is too small for more than one person.</li> <li>Risk Office. Shared offices are too small for more than one person.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Communication. Use phone/webconference to communicate (do not hand around doorways).</li> <li>Chairs. Remove/block guest chairs in offices.</li> <li>Risk office workstation. Remove 2<sup>nd</sup> workstation near door. Dedicate office for use by only one person. Ensure visitors (e.g., EH&amp;S Training Coordinator) use designated cubicle in the open workstation area.</li> </ul>
Cubicles	<ul> <li>Equipment. Shared printer (color) is located next to one employee's cubicle. No other network connections are available to move/relocate the equipment.</li> <li>Location. Four cubicles are side-by-side (close together).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Equipment. Purchase a color-printer for each employee</li> <li>Close/block every other cubicle. Install signs indicating which cubicle is to be taken out of service.</li> <li>Relocation. Relocate one employee to office (Cassandra Greenawalt). Relocate another employee to EH&amp;S Training Manager office (Heather Davis).</li> <li>Physical barrier. Install a temporary physical barrier to separate employee (My-Linh Tran) from foot traffic near exit.</li> <li>Door. Keep glass door closed at all times.</li> </ul>
Conference Room	• Space size. Space is too small for full team group meetings at this time	<ul> <li>Maximum capacity. Ensure no more than 1 person in room at any time. Restrict use as much as possible.</li> <li>Face coverings. Wear face coverings in this space</li> <li>Webconference. Conduct routine COE meetings remotely using zoom.</li> <li>EH&amp;S building. Move required in-person meetings to EH&amp;S building.</li> <li>Schedule. Use outlook calendar to reserve space.</li> </ul>
Recording Studio	<ul> <li>Space size. Space is too small for full team group meetings at this time</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Maximum capacity. Ensure no more than 1 person in room at any time. Restrict use as much as possible.</li> <li>Face coverings. Wear face coverings in this space</li> <li>Schedule. Designate one day in the week that each person can use (see Stage 3 schedule).</li> </ul>

## **Training & Communication**

All employees and affiliates to the space are required to complete:

- 1. COVID-19 return to work training
- 2. Worksite specific plan training

## **Investigation**

- Inspections. The work area is evaluated daily in compliance with this plan.
- Investigations. COVID-19 illnesses are investigated by the Training Director on an immediate case-by-case basis.
   Additional investigations may occur from the local public health department (UCR Health) and/or Workers Compensation program (Sedgwick).
- Contributing factors. Work-related factors that could have contributed to risk of infection are N/A (there have been no illnesses).
- Corrections. Plan updates since last investigation include:

## **Contact tracing**

Close contacts (within 6' for 10 minutes or more) of an infected employee include: N/A (there have been no illnesses)

Actions taken to isolate positive employees and close contacts include:

- Direct employee to isolate at home (following CDC)
- Restrict visitors / close contacts from the work area

## **Guidelines**

#### **VERIFICATION**

Before reopening, we have:

- Performed a detailed risk assessment and implement a sitespecific protection plan COMPLETED 05/18/20
- Train employees on how to limit the spread of COVID-19, including how to screen themselves for symptoms and stay home if they have them IN PROGRESS
- Implement individual control measures and screenings IN PROGRESS
- 4. Implement disinfecting protocols COMPLETED 05/18/20
- Implement physical distancing guidelines COMPLETED 05/18/20

In addition building-specific guidance has been issued by campus and UCOP. You are expected to follow the guidance provided in the **EH&S Return to Work guide** (UCR) and UC Intellicenter guidance.

#### STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

All staff must adhere to the following procedures each time they report onsite.

#### **Before** Complete health screening (app, guidance, and/or online survey) at home, before coming to work. If you experience any symptoms: A) Do not come to work, B) Ensure you use appropriate leave time for that day, and C) Follow CDC guidelines for isolation. 2. Bring your face covering to the work area. Follow signs indicating where they are to be used in the office. During Wash hands frequently with soap for at least 20 seconds. If needed, use disposable gloves and/or hand sanitizers provided at each workstation or dispensers installed throughout the building. 4. Physical distancing. Keep 6' distance from others. Limit your footprint (do not venture outside of your assigned workstation). After Disinfect using sanitizing wipes and/or spray before you leave for the day. This should be done at least in the last 30 minutes of the workday.
