- Description:** Multnomah University is seeking qualified individuals to serve as adjunct faculty members in its online programs. - Minimum Requirements:** The ideal candidate will possess a minimum of a master's degree (doctorate preferred) in a relevant field. Teaching experience preferred but not necessary. Agreement with the National Association of Evangelicals Statement of Faith required.
- Institutional Information:** Multnomah University includes undergraduate and graduate programs as well as Multnomah Biblical Seminary located in Portland, OR. All programs are coeducational and interdenominational. Founded in 1936, the university, graduate school, and seminary have established a renowned heritage of excellence in biblical education equipping Christian men and women to transform our culture and the world. Multnomah University is accredited with the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU).
