

IMMUNIZATION CONSENT (OPTIONAL IMMUNIZATIONS)

IF YOU WISH TO HAVE YOUR CHILD IMMUNIZED AGAINST THE FOLLOWING DISEASES. PLEASE PLACE YOUR SIGNATURE ON THE LINE NEXT TO EACH VACCINE. THESE ARE NON-MANDATORY BUT ARE HIGHLY RECOMMENDED BY THE CDC:

HEPATITIS A: (Two dose series)

A food borne illness that can last for several weeks with symptoms of diarrhea, vomiting and fever. Vaccine usually provides lifetime immunity.

Most common side effect - soreness at injection site.



HUMAN PAPILLOMA VIRUS (HPV): (Three dose series).

Prevents cervical cancer in girls and head, neck, anal and penile cancer in boys.

Most common side effect - soreness at injection site)

MENINGITIS B: (Two dose series)

Infection of the lining of the brain and spinal cord. Protects against meningococcal disease caused by serogroup B. (This is different than the Menveo/Menactra mandatory vaccine that protects against serogroups ACWY). College students are more at risk for this disease. 80% of meningitis cases in 18-23 year olds are Meningitis B. Certain colleges are already mandating this vaccine.

Most common side effects - injection site pain, fatigue, headache and joint pain.

INFLUENZA: (Yearly dose)

Serious illness which includes fever, body aches, sore throat, coughing, and can also lead to pneumonia. Child may miss 1-2 weeks of school.

Most common side effects - mild aches, fatigue.
