Please note that many students pay fees beyond those presented here, such as course fees (which vary by discipline) and student insurance fees.

³ The effective date of each new NSEOF rate varies by campus. Bothell will begin charging its new rate in Winter 2021 to students entering as part of the Winter 2021 cohort. Seattle will begin charging its new rate in Spring 2021 to students entering as part of the Fall 2021 cohort. Tacoma will begin charging its new rate in Winter 2021 to students entering in the Spring 2021 cohort.

⁴ Tacoma's U-PASS fee of \$45/quarter was first charged in Spring 2019. For UW Tacoma students residing in Thurston County, the U-PASS fee is \$20/quarter, or \$60 for the regular academic year.

⁵ Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, U-PASS and YMCA fees have been suspended for certain quarters. The 2019-20 and 2020-21 rates show the rates approved by Regents.
