Resolution Regarding Duane Storti Lawsuit Settlement

WHEREAS, President Richard McCormick violated the Faculty Code in 2002 when he suspended the salary policy that mandated a 2% salary increase for meritorious faculty, and;

WHEREAS, the class-action lawsuit initiated by Professor Duane Storti has been settled in a manner that restores the lost 2% merit increase and validates the Faculty Code;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Faculty Senate commends Duane Storti, Associate Professor of Mechanical Engineering, for having the courage and commitment to defend the Faculty Code and the 2% salary policy, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Faculty Senate commends Mark Emmert, President of the University of Washington, for having the courage and wisdom to resolve the lawsuit in a way that supports the Faculty Code and the salary policy.
