



**Proposed Class B Legislation
Policy Regarding President's Medallion
Volume Four, Part III, Chapter 11, Section 3: Grades, Honors and Scholarship**

Present Code Language	Proposed Changes
<p>Section 3. Honors Awards</p> <p>A. The President's Medal shall be conferred at Commencement upon the graduating senior who has the most distinguished academic record. A transfer student who is eligible for University honors may be considered for the President's Medal.</p> <p><i>S-B 86, November 1961; S-B 138, December, 1981: both with Presidential approval</i></p>	<p>Section 3. Honors Awards</p> <p>A. The President's Medal shall be conferred at <u>the annual Commencement ceremonies, upon the graduating senior who has the most distinguished academic record.</u> A transfer student who is eligible for University honors may be considered for the President's Medal.</p> <p>i. <u>At the Seattle commencement ceremony, a President's Medal shall be conferred upon the graduating senior who has completed at least three-fourths of his or her degree requirements at the University of Washington Seattle campus and who has the most distinguished academic record among such students. The President's Medalist shall be selected from among graduating seniors eligible for University Honors.</u></p> <p>ii. <u>Also at the Seattle commencement ceremony, a President's Medal shall be conferred upon the graduating senior who entered the University of Washington Seattle campus with at least 60 transfer credits from a Washington community college, and who has the most distinguished academic record among such students. The President's Medalist shall be selected from among graduating seniors eligible for University Honors.</u></p> <p>iii. <u>At each of the Bothell and Tacoma commencement ceremonies, a medal shall be conferred upon the graduating senior with the most distinguished academic record.</u></p>
