

Faculty Council on Tri-Campus Policy
2020-2021 Annual Report

Summary:

During the 2020-2021 academic year, the Faculty Council on Tri-Campus Policy met six times in regular meetings, conducting its routine business of relevance to all three UW campuses (UW Seattle, UW Tacoma, UW Bothell). Details of these actions can be found in the meeting minutes, which are located on the council's page on the UW Faculty Senate website. In addition to the routine business outlined above, the following non-routine business was conducted.

Major topics the council worked to address and/or completed during the year include:

- **Class C Resolution: Concerning the tri-campus relationship**

The council proposed, and the Faculty Senate approved on February 25, 2021, a resolution supporting the cooperation between Bothell, Tacoma, and Seattle campus leadership and redefining the current Faculty Code.

- **UW Curriculum Committee**

FCTCP reviewed and approved three curricular process changes brought by UWCC, including a reduced Notice of Proposal process timeframe from 15 to 10 business days, and involving advisors in the NOP process.

- **Faculty ADR & Grievance**

The council reviewed and supported the Alternative Dispute Resolution and Faculty Grievances and the Corrective Action and Disciplinary Proceedings recommendations by task force leaders Zoe Barsness and Amanda Paye.

- **Proposed Class A Legislation – Senate Committee on Planning and Budgeting**

The council proposed legislation regarding the addition of representatives from Bothell, Tacoma, and the Medical School to SCPB. This legislation is currently under revision to be brought back to SEC and Senate in Fall '21.
