Results of Online Quiz Data Analysis by Zoller

Zoller showed the Council results of the data he had analyzed regarding the use of online quizzes for his Chem 152 class this quarter. The data showed that fewer people were taking the online quizzes later in the quarter than at the beginning, but that the more quizzes students took over the quarter, the higher the average quiz grade. This indicates that the students learned more and did better as a result of taking online quizzes.
