- Travel Clinic (Standard) \$100 → **Good to budget for, but may not need.**
- Immunizations \$300 → **Depends on program location—may not need.**

WHEN COST DUE	HOW TO PAY
Prior to departure	Savings, Short-Term Loan, airfare deposits
While abroad	Savings, Short-Term Loan, financial aid (if not Early Fall)
Tuition deadline	Savings, financial aid

Set amount all students pay.

Due: tuition deadline (autumn)

Varies dependent on program.

In your control. Shop at local markets to save!

Due: while abroad

Look for cheap flights and consider airfare deposit programs.

Due: prior to departure

If don't already have passport. Visas vary dependent on program location—may not need.

Due: prior to departure
