They are not under the control of GN. Cancellation penalties may differ from the cruise-program-related penalties. AQSC may modify the cruise itinerary up to and during the voyage.

ADVANCE TRAVEL INFORMATION: U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the U.S. traveling exclusively inside U.S. borders do not need a passport or visa for travel. Homeland Secular laws require that all guests travel with government-issued photo identification (ID) (such as a driver's license) at all times. ID must be presented at the time of check-in, Guests without proper ID will be denied boarding. AOSC is required to provide all guests' ID information including ID number, expiration date, and place of issue to the Coast Guard and/or other government entities prior to the vessel's departure.
