Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for inventory and set up Café (beverages and snacks on display).

- · Source lunches using set budget for all staff and volunteers onsite daily.
- · Pre-event set up, including obtaining lunch sponsorships for the event.
- · Collection of receipts from all directors and reconciliation for onsite purchases.
