Planning Your Trip to Vegas

Whether you have been to Vegas before or not, it's important to spend a little time planning, especially if you are a big group (especially if it's all guys) or are looking to bypass the long admission lines.

While not every weekend is going to be sold out, there are quite a number of big weekend events. The busy times are caused by music festivals, holiday weekends, sporting events and conventions.

To guarantee that all of the pool parties - excluding hotel pools - will be open, you should plan your trip between the beginning of May through the middle of October.

1. Plan ahead.

Unless you live in Los Angeles or Phoenix you should give yourself about a month to plan the trip properly. This will allow you to get the best value when it comes to hotel rooms and flights. The first thing to take into consideration is when you are planning to come. Unless you are coming to Vegas to celebrate a holiday, we would recommend avoiding those busy times - Memorial Day, July 4th, etc. - as will get more value on a regular weekend than you will on a holiday weekend.

2. Stay on the Strip.

The Strip is where all of the fun is and you don't want to spend time and money cabbng it back-and-forth to the Strip so that you can save a couple bucks a night on your hotel room. Unless you and your party are going to a gun range or driving race cars there is really no reason to leave the strip. The hotels that are off of the Strip are not what they once were and all of the places, nightclubs, shows, concerts, and the best pool parties are on the Las Vegas Strip. We can offer you discounted rates on a hotel room, as low as 25% below what you will find online.

3. Figure out what you want to do.

It is always good to have a plan, especially if you are planning on partying at a pool party, eating at one of the new restaurants, or seeing a show. Planning ahead, whether you are booking bottle service or just general admission tickets, will save you time and money. If you book last minute for bottle service you are going to pay more for a less desirable table than if you make your reservations in advance. Even just getting into a nightclub when you don't have pre-sale tickets will cause you to stand in line. Some of these lines can take two to three hours to get through.

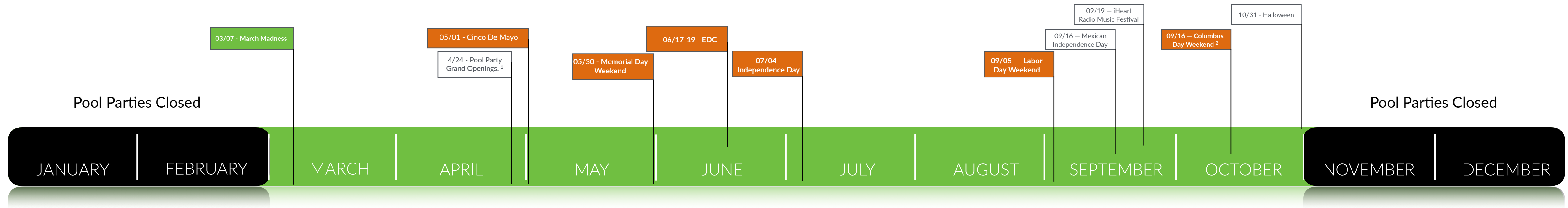
4. Determine a Budget per Event per Day

Having a budget is always a good idea, especially if you are coming with a group. Not everyone has or is willing to spend the same amount of money on partying. It works better if you have a rough itinerary, with one or two events that are confirmed and then you can play the rest by ear.

Pool Season Calendar



There are 12 pool parties on the Las Vegas Strip. Pool season is generally from the middle of March to the middle of October. The exact dates vary depending on the weather.

While most of the pools will be open the second weekend of March, the big over the top pool parties usually will not kick-off until **Cinco De Mayo** weekend and usually run through **Columbus Day Weekend**.

Making reservations for pool parties is a little different than 'getting a table' at a nightclub or a cabana at a hotel pool. The minimum is based on the location and you can bring up-to a certain amount of people.

POOL PARTY DRESS CODE

Women

Are required to wear a swimsuit with a sundress or wrap. While some wear high heels, wedges, flip-flops, running shoes are acceptable.

Men

Should wear board shorts, a T-shirt and sandals or flip-flops, although sneakers and running shoes are also permitted.

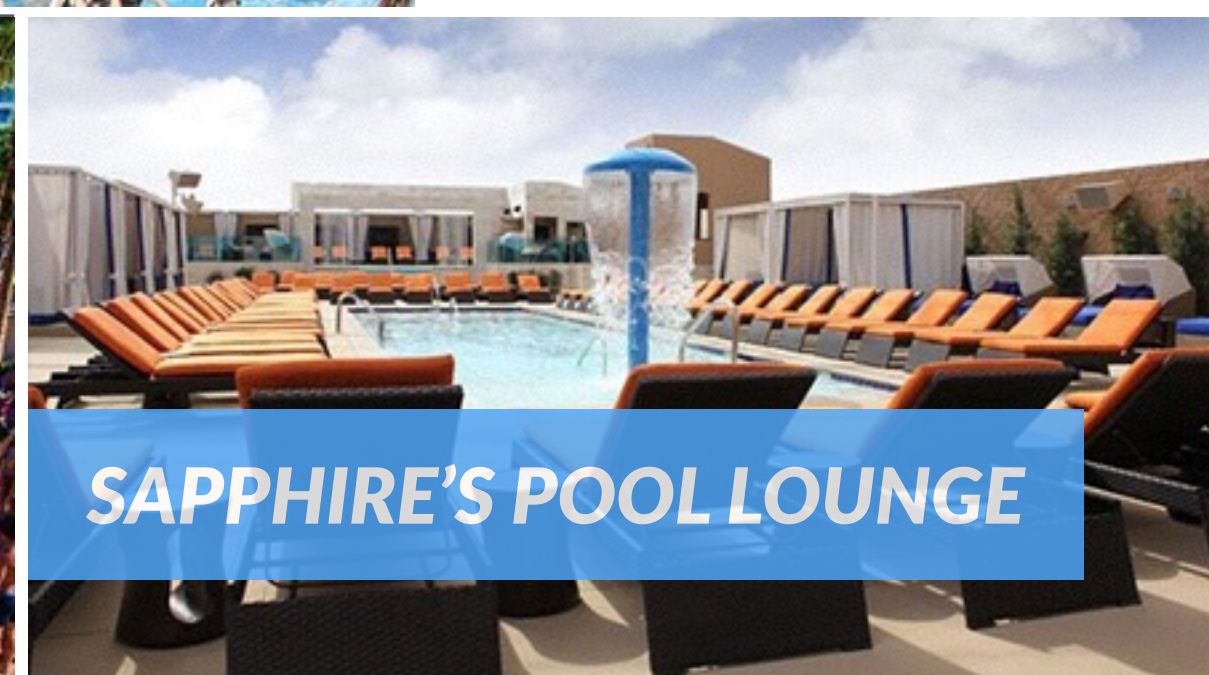
You will need to be covered and wearing shoes when walking through the hotels and casinos. If you are stopped they won't let you proceed until covered.

DO NOT WEAR: undershirts (white T-shirts), cut-off shorts, baggy clothes, chains, see-through swim wear, and athletic wear like gym shorts, or sports jerseys are absolutely forbidden.

Most of the hotel pools require that you are staying with the hotel to check them out.

To reserve cabanas, daybeds, bungalows or lounge chairs at a hotel pool you are going to need to contact the hotel directly.

2. **Book a hotel**. If you want the best, Encore tower suites, Cosmopolitan, or the Cromwell are perfect.
3. **Pick a place for the dinner**. We recommend SW and Carne Vino for steak and STK for atmosphere. Not into steak, go to Carbone.
4. **Go to a Strip Club**. Purchase a bachelor party package, it includes limo, VIP admission, a reserved table and waived cover charge.
5. **Play Golf**. Reserve tee times at an area golf course. Stay close to the strip and play at Wynn(hotel guests only,) or Bali Hai Golf Course.
6. **Party at a Pool**. There are not many things better than partying at one of the pool parties. We recommend Wet Republic, Marquee Dayclub or Drai's Beach Club.
7. **Get bottle service**. Reserve bottle service at a nightclub or pool party at least for one of the days that you are in Vegas.

DJs / Artists

In 2016 the pool parties and nightclubs has a little more to offer you than previous years when it seemed like the only thing that you could here was top 40 & electronic.

This year you can still see Calvin Harris or Tiesto as well as many other EDM type DJs in the main room of Omnia and Hakkasan but you can also find more hip-hop being played with Snoop Dogg, Nicki Minaj, Nas, and J.Cole all performing in Vegas.

While each venue usually has their own terminology they all fit into one of these categories.

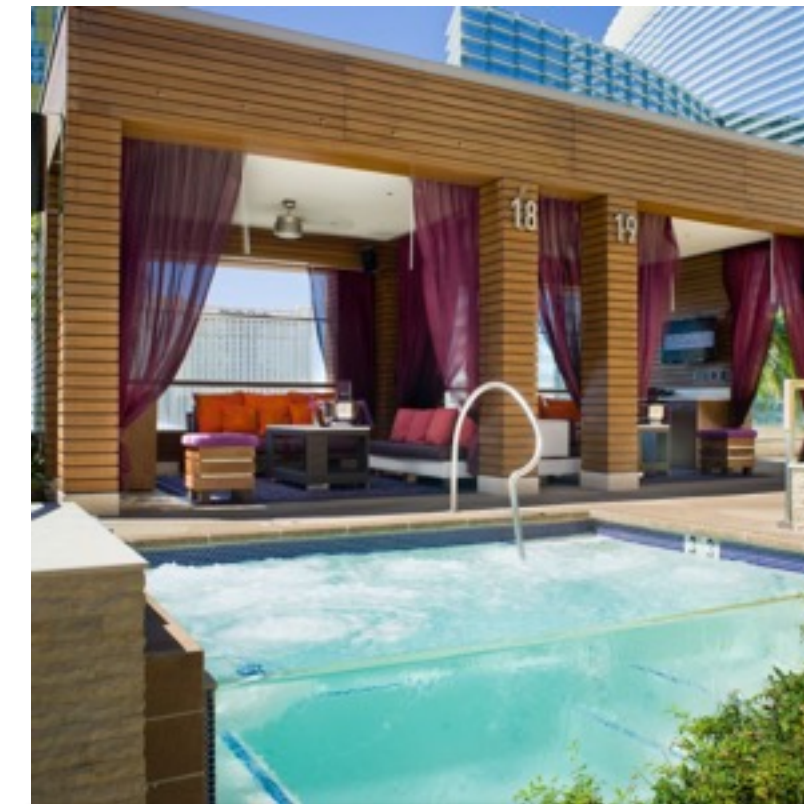
Each venue has a table or area that is the most coveted and priced that way.

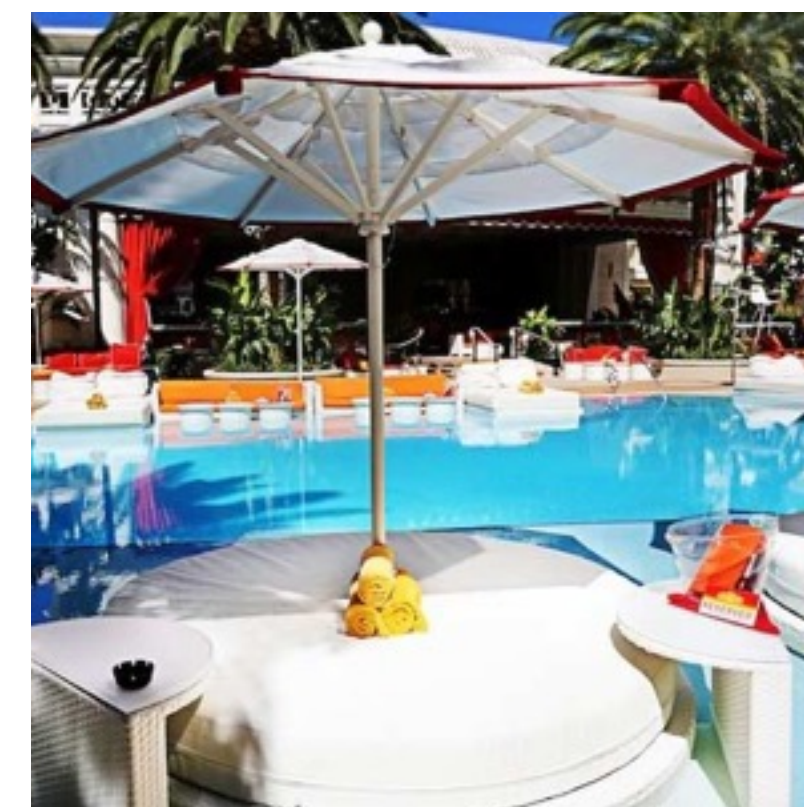

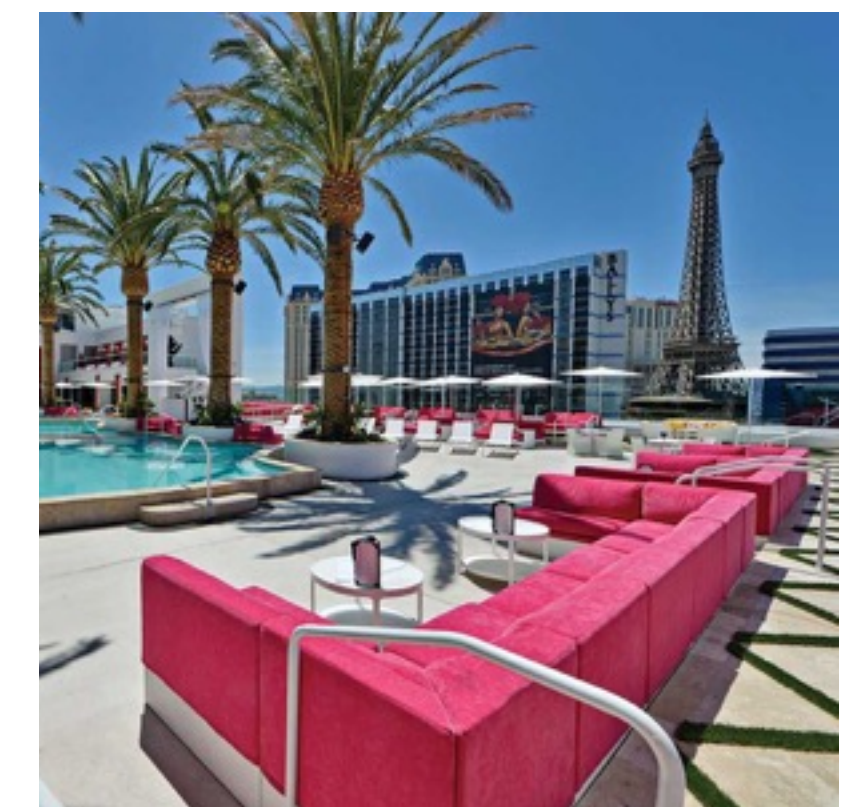

What is Bottle Service?

Bottle Service or table service is where you have a reserved VIP area within a nightclub or dayclub and agree to spend a minimum amount at the club on liquor.

It is the only way to guarantee somewhere to sit and the clubs refer to you as a VIP client. there is no cover charge applicable and you don't need to join the general admission line.

Your VIP area comes with a table, daybed, cabana or bungalow, seating, cocktail server and security and is usually booked when your group has four or more people but there is no minimum group size.

Pricing

The pricing for seating at a pool party can change dramatically depending on whether the reservation date is mid-week, Friday/Sunday vs Saturday, Holiday Weekend, a special event or a big DJ is performing.

- Weekday Pricing
- Weekend Pricing (Usually Fridays & Sundays)
- Saturday Pricing
- Special Event Pricing

What is the Minimum Spend?

This is the amount of money that you agree to spend in liquor, beer, water, energy drinks, and food when applicable. Day Clubs or Pool Parties have minimum spends associated with different seating types, a cabana (seats 12) and daybed (seats 8). Depending on the pool, each step up in seating type will cost approximately 30-60% more depending on the weekend.

The minimum spend or “minimum” will be the lowest during the week (Monday to Thursday), most expensive on Saturday and about 30% cheaper on Fridays and Sundays.

The bottle services prices will vary from venue-to-venue, but the average bottle prices for a 750ml bottle of Grey Goose is \$500.00 before tax.

This is before taxes, service charges and tip.

- Nevada Sales Tax - 8.1%
- LET (Live Entertainment Tax) - 10.0%
- Gratuity (waitress & busser) - 18-20%
- Service Charges - 3-5%
