Vision Sociology Test # 814 Name - Ila Tripatine Reg # ^{a)} <u>Positivism aims to study sociology as anatual science</u> through observation and facts. Many as romanticism positivist, did not absolutely believe in deploying scientific means to the study of society. In The communist manifesto, marx mentions listory of membind as history of struggle. class antagemen did net exist in primiture communal societies but it excepted in capitalist society. In case of class conflict, facts and observation cannot explain the conflict. The false consciousness created by <u>bourgeoisie</u> among protestanast needs subjective observation. In Das Kapital, Marx mentions relation of production being gonerned by factors of production. This might look objecture seality but to undeustand the way it divided the society we must subjectively study how control over one resource determinet class. Even to understand an objective materialism like ownership of land, capital one should understand dialectic. This term of Kegel was onficised by Maex on the ground that social existence leads to consciousness, Notle the other way round. In a sum, Moux peroposes a holistic n'ew of class conflict in his study of society which requines more them mere faste and data.

(b) Emile Duskheim opines division of labour in train. society leads to organic solidarity. As people become commens they become interdependent thus fostering collaboration. This is more effective than mechanic collaboration. This is more effective than mechanic solidently where people here less dypenentiation and one kounded by cellective consciousness of beliefs.

In the above roves, division of labour does not contribute to solidarity. In angenia anomic ToL, there is lack of regulation leading to chaou, in forod DoL there is too much regulation leading to suppression of individualism. In lack of coordination, interdependence takes a beating.

In functional cases, Dol serves as a normal social fact while in anomic Dol, it becomes pathological social fact

Goodlocke chiticises Demkheim for misinterprotig cystem integrity and interdependence as social integrity

integnity Malinowski criticises Darkheim for equating Division of labour with human progress.

As a functionalist, Duskheim dnanne utility of division of labour as fostering solidarity and also showing its pathological side

(2C) Economics deals with the study of monetary and fiscal components regulating a system. In micro conony we study balance of demand and supply while in macroseconomy we study aunilative market forces. However, the discussion on means of peroduction, market forces form as compensed of Sociology - a study of Louery. Economy explains the production cycle while sociology explains why the producer drose to perduce. teals with impact of an economic decision on people cuero make up une mersket! In other words, Economy failutades the study of sociology. As an older science, Geonomy acts as a precurson to seadlogy Seterministic theories during to intruisin of Adam Smith's Lassine Frime. Theory of Dependence by Prebis helps social change in colonial times. caplain Thus, it be safe to conclude Economics bolging sociology, the younged of de sciences, in forming theories explaining impact on economy and society.

3(a) Max meber as an interpretative sociologiers terreted that Sociology rannot be explained but oneyundenstood tourener, he did believe in general patterns in society To study these general patterns he derived 4 sociological methods: (1) verteben - interpretative understanding (2) causal penaerlity (3) Value Neutrality (4) Ideal Type

Ideal Type mas essentially a construct of exhaustine reality through selective means.

"The Protestant Ethic and spirit of Capitalism"

This mas a viticism of Maoix which gome an economic determinist theory where social economy inferenced and shaped seligion

Meber creates an ideal type construct of mestern Earsope's Capitalist societies and found that they all practiced protestant faith.

The faith had a 'pre-destined' aspert of 'the elect' who would go to treamen. Calminist, unlike witherams, mosked hand to assume themselves that they'se the 'elect'. They did not indulge in easury, plaughed back their income / profit in business thus gring suise to capitalism.

Here ideal type serves the purpose of an enpiriment. It is used a classification tool to term a reitain faiter responsible for economic phenomena. Ideal Type construct creates a factual rationale since capitalism dequired accounting and mombers. Unlike supermitural sational of religion.

nuber also applies are model of ideal type on larger scale by generalising mester emopean societies as capitalist and protectants.

Tonneyantsuises Weher for comideing gereadisettion Bintain mas the first capitalist notion but not productant Bistain was catholic that time.

protestant faits led to capitalism

leter sombert questrois how ascetic protestants supported à consumer oriented capitalist montet. subs mould consume?

Hence, Meker's ideal type finds selemance in explaining capitation as a product of protestant faiter. Prior to meker, Sociology depended sawly on scientific methods. Ideal type provided a method to undestand society. 3(b) Emile Duskheim was a stand pointimet and finctionalist who proposed composative method meber, as an interactionist, believed society to study society.

could not be explained but only understood

Duskhein studied society by comparing the contemporany with history. In his book, 'Elementary towns of study of Religions toms' studies primitive Annta trike of Anstralia to understand complex forme. meker on the other hand used i deal type to create a model of exhaustine reality. In his experiment "The Perotestant Ethic and spirit of Capitalism' capitalism is explained through protestant seligion.

Duorkheim was a functionalist who beliened energ social component errs a function. Even come served the purpose of bringing to attention the solidericty needed meber too believed in utility of social phenomena but in their ideal form. Buneaucracy mas an effecture organisation if it was blessed with sulles, technical expertise, impersonisation.

Dinkheim nieured social fact as the subject matter of social ogy. social fact have externality, practice constraints and can be generalized. Waker betweened rocial astron was the subject matter of sociology. social actions are directed by om individual towards ether individual.

Doskheim selated economy with politics while Weber saw politics as an independent entity. According to Durkeheim, Division of Labour blads to formation of State. meber said power and state are interrelated where State exercises power through administration

Durkenein divided society on the basis of lakon meker to divided the society into 4 classes -<u>Propertied Opper class</u>, while collar moskers, <u>Petty Borngeaire</u>, Manual Laborn - based on labour and economic factors

of Malinanski and Timasheff was enaggerating and ones simplication. Meber is criticised for his social action theory by Parsons and Pareto.

Durkheim and Meber both have made remarkable contribution to study of society knouge functionalism and interactionsin respectively 4(a) Parsons mas a structural functionalist who believed in studying society thorough <u>social systems</u> Each system was to contribute to <u>social equilibrium</u> by peremening change.

He suggested study of AGIL as functional <u>pre-sequisites</u> to mointain stability. Various social systems - Policy, Economy, Fiduciary, Social contributed to reinforcing the existing systems.

This theory is criticised for being as 'status goo' maintenance where change is resided.

Cohen vivicises <u>laevons</u> for interpreting change as conflict.

Even in modern society where social chang is weined as perognessive, Parsons results it by saying it led to ense of <u>isclated mucleas ferminés</u> <u>trocromits oriticises Parsons for being opposed to</u> change.

In theory of 'Pattern variables', Parsons yet again classifies patterns in which man behaves <u>Denereux</u> coîtéases Parsons that one cannot give an exhaudine eix of patter variable while Pausons sestinds trimself to 5.

Heme, Pauson neured change determental to equilibrium and this adro cated status qui . 4 (b) Maria defined <u>Aliendion</u> in relation to endning selation between the peroduct and the peroducer.

In primiture communation eocity, the labour fett a connect and ownership towards the tim he produced the puoduced based on his liking towever with mise of capitalism, peofit maximisation was the objecture and labour became mondanous denoid of ownership.

In present day capitalism, profit maximuzation objective have become more strongly reinforced due to increased competition from globalsiation. Laboures now work in silos, in day as well as nglit singles with minimum people to people connect. Technical advancement home reduced men to mene hende obeying instructions.

Houvener, in present time the sector is dea becoming degulated to prevent alienation. There are Labouer Lams and social security Schemes that emerne labourer eremains a roade being as meel.

Marcuse's viticism of Mean ifinds rebrance today as capitalists too suffer forom alienation. Robert's airticism that technical advancement leads to alienation also holds towe.

Hence, alienation as peroposed by More separates soul from the production process and it finds relevance even a century letter. 41() Durkheim wrole 'Elementary turdy of keligian Form' while studying primitive religion of Asunta Touke of Australia

Durkhein opined totems to be inaminate objects of mostlip. Sacred and Bridgane mene items kept sooned. For ex- shoes that we used to walk one mundame objects not allowed in holy places. He studied pointime toubles so as to apply leasings in complex religions as well

An Dinkheim say that Totom was the "primitive form of deligion? Edmind Leech questions Dunkheim for over-simplifying religion

geneirs il more important as a collecture force than individual. It is the morship of society.

Evens-Pritchard criticises that Totem is not a universal plrenomena in every society.

Durkheim seis deligionas functional since cheates a feeling of <u>collective effensescence</u> ulile performing situals. Religion also <u>cements</u> soldanity in the society

Freubraug in 'Essence of clinistiamity' vitilises functional role of keligion by sugning it makes people weak by believing in God.

Durchenns view on siele of religion as functional is vital in understanding complex religions that developed latter

5(a) Charles Colley opined that an individual shapes his individual self by interactions unter everyone he meete at every stage - Mead made reservations on this and said our individual self is moulded by interaction with specific people at certain stages of life. These interactions dore 'socio-symbolic' Mead as the promoter of Symbolic School of sociology peroposes a non-positivists approach. Misch like other sociologist of chicago School. Mead says the interactions take plane in three stages - preparatory stage, play stage and the game stage. Initially, there is no interaction. only initation. Then there is role play where infants become amone of noles played by people At final stage, there is development of generalised self where chied becomes arrane of the fact that people have expectations from him and he is expected to before in accordance with the Standards. This results in development of the 'Me' which is different fron 'I'. Mead however banks hearing on 'septective intelligence' of people as pointed out by Patrick

Mead also onerlooks any suepe for objectivity and is criticised by the <u>Positivists</u>. BH Mead offened a distinction b/w symbolic interactions and passive seglection through development of the socially conscious sey of me? 5(b) Meeten supported functionalism by gring it beroader interpretation

He improved <u>Riddliffes Bnowns</u> structural functionalism by saying institutions can not only be functional but also non-functional and dypfunctional <u>for ex-</u> if Buneaucracy does not perform its job it becomes non functional and if gets heariery influenced by politicians in its working it becomes dipfunctional

Merton imperorned Darkheim the very of Anomie by codifying demiance. He said demance occurs when either or both of instituionalised goels or means are not conformed with.

He was able to explain <u>Stauffeurs</u> care study on American soldiers thorough usage of reference group theory. Emmanuel Stauffeur found that soldiers at war were happier than soldiers at contonment. Merton suggested reference group as points to evaluate on's behaviour. Soldiers at war had their seniors as reference group hence were happy while at contonment soldiers had their ainilian friends as reference group.

Merton through desirance Homener is viticised for not accounting monetary courses of demiance by P. Cohen. Marxists ortreise Meiton for not ace ounting for impact of economy in anomie. Menton peromed instrumental in peromiding Objectivity to highly subjective sprene functionalism in promoting anticipatory socialization.

Moux was on <u>economic</u> determinist who believed every dronge in society is a presult of change in economic perocess.

uleker on the other hand believed in social actions to be determinist and capitalism to be an effect not a sauce. Weber orticis man for his mono-causal new on capitalism.

In this book '<u>Renduction</u> and <u>Counter</u> <u>Renduction</u> in <u>Aymony</u>' Maeter opines capitalism leading to inequality meber homener believes capitalism does not cause as much concentration of authronity as does <u>kineasurage</u> <u>Marks capitalist society is divided vito 2 broad</u> <u>Joends - keurgeoisie and proletainal while hieker's</u> <u>capitalist society is divided vito 2 broad</u> <u>Joends - keurgeoisie and proletainal while hieker's</u> <u>capitalist society is divided vito 4 major classes</u> <u>O</u> Property ourning upper class <u>3</u> white collar class

Socielogy as by-product of IR

Industrial Revolution occurred in the 19th conting with the invention of the spinning Jenny. Thinkers like Wallestern and Another Frank opine that colonation led to Industrial Revolution. More believed that capitalism was the major effect of industrial aevolution.

With the industrial Revolution, there was migration of workforce, division of labour, momen participation in production, technological advancement with machines and assembly line. These factors had direct impact on the society; the Inductionship between various societal indistributions like household, education, family begon to change. Relationship between men also transformed as they got polarised into the - Houses and Home Nets (Maox).

The changing dynamics were already promoting thrinkers of the <u>'social contract'</u> Phase during the Age of Reason and the French <u>Renaisance</u> (1789) The Industrial Revolution acted as a catalyst in France, Guimary, Britain and to eink it with society. Thus the size of Socialogy - study of Socialywas scripted by the eikes of comte, Rousseau, Locke, Goldthorpe and Karl Maerx.

(6) Suicide as a social fact According to Durkheim, social face is the subject matter of sociology. These are observable faits that have following features: -> Externality > constraind > Generalisation Suide is a sociological fact since it is guided by external features like segnention and integrity sligh segulation leads to Fatalistic suicide like in a slame society while low integration leads to anome equistic sincide. Suicide also experiences contraint. High integration constants individual to even die for so city like suicide bombers (Altruistic fricide) suicide can also be generalised based on prevaling social conditions - Depression in economy causes people to commit anomic suicides. Suicide is a normal social fact but it becomes pathological when rates of suicide increase abnormally.

Marcuse conticises Durkheim as suicide cannot. enlybe cocially doinen. neycom allo be molurated by indusidual / pychological canses. Graboniel Taorde's theory of immitation suites out erde of suicide as a social fact.

Denkheim persposes a mono-nationt version of Suicide as a social fact urbene only social causes perompt suicide (C) Poorsons, as a structural functionalist, famour ed status que by argning social equilibrium through functional presequences.

He persposed the AGIL model.

A - Adaptation: Emissionment of an individual shapes his behaviour and consequently shapes the economy G - Goal Adirevement - This is to be achieved by the state and polity

I - Integration: Fiduiciony instruments of law and police ensure societal norms are integrated L - Latency and Tension Management - This is sugnlated by education and seeligion.

Functional Pre requisites address the common needs of a social system - notion of functionality, internal dynamics and structure of society

This appoilach aims at fostering social equilibrium. According to Parrons, Input cutput theory, the four presequintes pravide input to each other and hence integrale kouldy.

Moromitzend Positinists homener cuiticise

the model as being over-dependent where one system reinforces the other inclead of doing soles individually.

Functional pre-nequisites ome thus findarmental to structural function alion theory.

(d) Ruttonal - Legne Authority Long. Str. Weber classified social actions into 4 types and considered it as subject matter of sociology. Zweck/Groal oriented social action netults in rational-legal authority that brams legitimate pomer ferom the public through means like elections, referendum etc. Contemporary sogime drams pourer in a denocratic system from elections. Paintical leadens are nested with legal anthonity the eight means such as elect member of parliament, executive, judiciary-This type of authority draws power from legitmatey and is usually long lasting than toditional or chassismatic form. A legal trational leader can have chanisma as mell. social Media today has helped in creating personality cult for politicians.

wekens believed that authority was the source of power and not means of prods, Dahendoof chedded anthority for Social stratification

(C) social structure and deriance

Merton in lin ensay 'The Paradigm of Deniance' elaborates on Daarkheim's wew et anomie which he believes is the cause for deniance. Metton believes social structure is inflicted with anomie when there is normlessness. Norms are fou and the ouger cutural means and instituitionalised goals.

If an individual conforms to both there is no demonce. He becomes an <u>importor</u> if he uses uncultural means to become achiever of goals. Black Anencoms and an example.

Ritualists dis concl toth goals set by society but follow societally conforming means. Retreatists like hippie abolish both. Rebel meny abolish or acknowledge peroper means to achieve instituionalised goals.

Merton's Atheory is criticised by P. Cohen for not accounting for monetary causes behind divionce. James gradom uses drug perodr are study for explaining housiots when merton's theory is a landy tool b objectively inderstand demance
