discuss few more criticisms like -- 1. Despite its wide acceptance, Herzberg's theory has its detractors. Some say its methodology does not address the notion that when things are going well people tend to look at the things they enjoy about their job. When things are going badly, however, they tend to blame external factors.

2. the theory assumes a strong correlation between job satisfaction and productivity. Herzberg's methodology did not address this relationship, therefore this assumption needs to be correct for his findings to have practical relevance.

Herzberg's contribution in bringing out significance of three areas to motivation viz. importance of job content, different factors influencing different people and job enrichment was path breaking.

Herzberg's work led to the development of the concept of 'Job Enrichment'. It is based on the premise that people develop lasting motivation only through their experience with the content of their jobs. Herzberg explained that the principle of vertical loading whereby tasks of greater interest and responsibility their experience with the content of their jobs.
