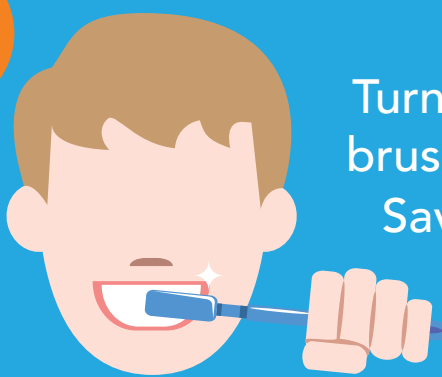

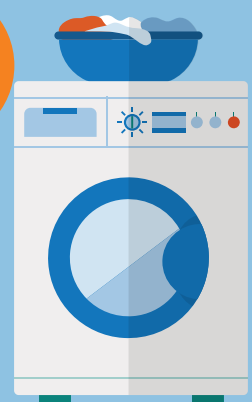

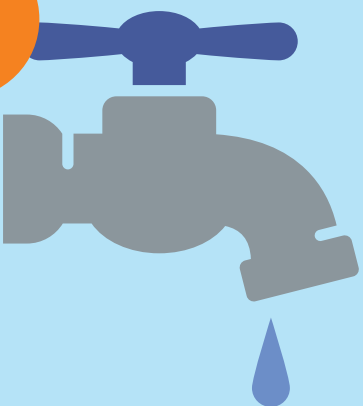
1 Reduce your shower by 1-2 minutes and save **5** gallons.



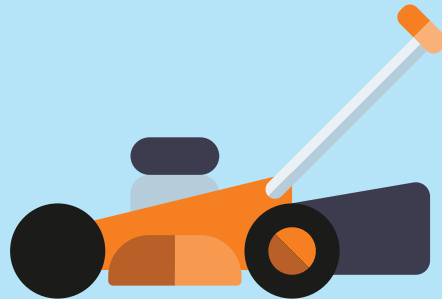
2 Turn water off while brushing your teeth. Save **3** gallons.



3 Wash a full load of laundry. Save **15** to **50** gallons per load.



4 Fix leaky faucets. Save up to **20** gallons per day.



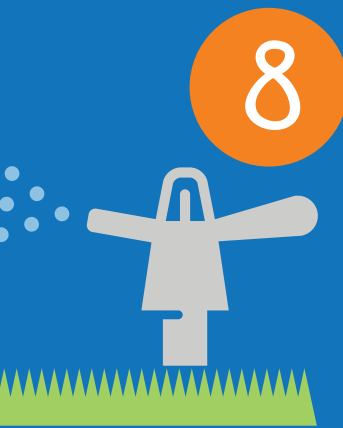
5 Raise your lawn mower blade to at least **3** inches. Taller grass holds soil moisture better than a closely cropped lawn.



6 You can save as much as **100** gallons of water cleaning your driveway by sweeping instead of using the hose.



7 Switch your garden to drought-tolerant plants and reduce your water use by more than **30** percent.



8 Look for lawn sprinklers that produce droplets, not mist.
