



CHAMPION RULES

The race to be named the Champion of the CLIF Crankworx Summer Series (CCSS) 2020 is a unique competition in mountain biking history as there may not ever be another time where a set group of athletes will mix and compete regularly across multiple disciplines. This 3 week-long, multidisciplinary challenge tabulates results from multiple event disciplines in a four-stop, epic test of a rider's skill and will. Racing the interior of BC from SilverStar to Kicking Horse to Sun Peaks, athletes aim to collect as many points as possible for a shot at winning the \$20,000 CAD prize. The most points wins.

TITLES / PRIZE MONEY

The top ranked Male and Female athlete competing in the CCSS will be recognized by receiving the Champion Title. Each awarded athlete will each receive \$10,000 CAD

Titles/Awards will be presented on Friday August 14th, 2020 at Sun Peaks Resort.

FORMAT

Comprising of 4 events; Downhill, Dual Slalom, Air DH & Enduro at 3 stops, the series is an 'all in' format with each athlete participating in all four events at every stop.

ELIGIBILITY

A rider must compete and collect points in all disciplines in order to be eligible to win the title/award.

Titles/awards will be based on results in the following individual events throughout the Crankworx Summer Series | British Columbia.

Dual Slalom Points will be awarded to; top 4 based on final results, top 5-16 based on ladder advancements and qualifying results (when applicable).

WOMEN | DUAL SLALOM, DOWNHILL, ENDURO

Points: 1st 100 | 2nd 85 | 3rd 70 | 4th 60 | 5th 50 | 6th 45 | 7th 40 | 8th 35

Dual Slalom Points will be awarded to; top 4 based on finals, top 5-8 based on ladder advancements and qualifying results (when applicable).

TIE BREAK

In the event of a tie on total points at the end of all relevant CCSS competitions, the following rules will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- (a) The most first place finishes, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most 3rd place finishes, or if still tied,
- (b) Head-to-Head results in all common races/competitions if applicable.
- (c) In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided.
