- But By chapter 10 I recommend you sell your David stock.
- Nathan, David and the fourfold prophecy. David will lose 4 sons. (II Samuel 12:6)
- Sons in Samuel. Eli's were Hophni and Phineas. Samuel's sons Joel and Abijah

II Samuel 12:18	First Child with Bathsheba
II Samuel 13:29	Son Ammon killed by Son Absalom
II Samuel 18:14	Absalom killed by nephew Joab
I Kings 2:25	Son Adonijah executed by his son Solomon

1. Humble men ______ to Nathans. Who is your Nathan?

Absalom's Story. His name means "My father is peace."

- Absalom Flees to Geshur. (II Samuel 13:28)
- Absalom's Beauty. (II Samuel 14:25-27)
- Absalom and Joab's field. (II Samuel 14:31)

 Steals the hearts of the people. (II Samuel 15:6 and 15:13)
2. Humble men (II Samuel 15:14).
3. Humble men (Psalm 3). "A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son.
 4. Humble men can be Shimei's cursing. David's honesty. (II Samuel 15:25 and 16:11) Absalom and David's Concubines. (II Samuel 16:22)
 Vengeance is mine, I will repay says the Lord. (Deuteronomy 32:35 and Romans 12:19) David spared Saul. (I Samuel 26:10-11). But God did not. (I Chronicles 10:14) David spared Shimei. Solomon did not. (I Kings 2:44-45) David spared Absalom. Joab did not. (II Samuel 18:14)
Our Hope is not in David but in the Cross.
