Personal Reflection/Application:

- **Listen** at the Work Place for the command: Have you been able to quiet your hearts at work/school/home to listen what the Lord might be commanding you to do? Can you hear a similar statement of “let down your nets” in your own setting?
- **Repentance and Worship:** Is there something we need to repent for after realizing Christ is LORD of our work environments? Have we been “astonished” by the acts of Christ in our jobs and responded in worship?
