Morals - (Webster)

- : of or relating to principles of right and wrong in behavior : ETHICAL
moral judgments
- : expressing or teaching a conception of right behavior
a *moral* poem
- : conforming to a standard of right behavior
- took a *moral* position on the issue though it cost him the nomination
- : sanctioned by or operative on one's conscience or ethical judgment
a *moral* obligation
- : capable of right and wrong action
a *moral* agent

Immoral - (Webster)

: not moral

broadly : conflicting with generally or traditionally held moral principles

murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false
testimony, slander.**

Acts 15:20 (NIV)

**Instead we should write to them, telling them
to abstain from food polluted by idols, from
sexual immorality, from the meat of strangled
animals and from blood.**

Romans 13:13-14 (NIV)

Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy. Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature.

1 Corinthians 6:13 (NIV)

Food for the stomach and the stomach for food—but God will destroy them both. The body is not meant for sexual immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.

1 Corinthians 6:18 (NIV)

Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body.

Colossians 3:5-6 (NIV)

Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. [6] Because of these, the wrath of God is coming

1 Thessalonians 4:3 (NIV)

**It is God's will that you should be sanctified:
that you should avoid sexual immorality;**

Revelation 9:21 (NIV)

**Nor did they repent of their murders, their
magic arts, their sexual immorality or their
thefts.**

Matthew 19:4-6 (NIV)

[6] So they are no longer two, but one. Therefore what God has joined together, let man not separate.”
