(1) Numbers 11:17, 25-29 (Moses & Transference of Spirit)

(2) II Kings 2:9, 15 (Elijah & Elisha)

(3) Romans 8:9 (Spirit of God/Christ) John 20:22 (Breathed on them)

Transference: "To convey, carry, remove, or send from one person, place, or position to another."

Transfigure: "To change the figure, form, or outward appearance of."

Reproduction: "To produce again; make, form, or bring into existence again or anew in some way; To make a copy."

S(s)pirit: "The prevailing attitude or characteristics of something or someone."

****The Spirit of someone, or something is there to reproduce that spirit and its ways, whether for good or bad.

1 Cor. 15:33-34 (Amp) "Do not be deceived and misled! Evil companionships (Communion, Associations) corrupt and deprave good manners and morals and character."

"Awake (from your drunken stupor and return) to sober sense and your right minds, and sin no more. For some of you have not the knowledge of God - you are utterly and willfully and disgracefully ignorant, and continue to be so, lacking the sense of God's presence and all true knowledge of Him."

Proverbs 13:20 - "He that walketh with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed."

2nd Cor. 6:14-18 - "Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion hath light with darkness? Or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel? For Ye are the temple of the Living God: as God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God and they shall be my people."

Wherefore come out and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing: and I will receive you and I will be a Father unto you..."

Pride: "An overhigh opinion of oneself: exaggerated self-esteem, haughty behavior resulting from Arrogance."

King Solomon was the wisest man and yet he fell pray to the spirit of his wives and concubines, and his wives turned away his heart, as God had warned him of in 1 Kings 11: 1-3.

Fear transference: Deuteronomy 20:8 - "And the officers shall speak further unto the People, and they shall say, what man is fearful and faint-hearted? Let him go and return unto his house, lest his brother's heart faint as well as his heart."

*******Like a sponge, the spirit of man may absorb whichever spirit it is in association and fellowship with. (1 Cor. 2:11-12)**

Physical Strength: Samson was strong and powerful physically, so he thought he could withstand the spiritual forces.

Judges 16:20 - ("For Samson did not know the Lord had departed from him.")

*****His downfall was assuming because he was blessed in one area, God would overlook the other area.**

Psalms 1:1 - "Blessed is the man who walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly..."

Romans 8:6-7 - "For to be carnally minded is death: but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. Because the carnal mind is enmity (makes you the enemy) against God..."

Various categories of spirits that can transfer:

- 1. The spirit of association one on one.**
- 2. The spirit of the group.**
- 3. The spirit of an association.**
- 4. The spirit of an area or city.**

5. The spirit of state or country.
6. The spirit of the world (which is lawlessness)

Galations 5:9 (Amp) - "A little leaven (a slight inclination to error, or a few false teachers) leavens the whole lump (it perverts the whole conception of faith.)"

The Method of operation.

1. The spirit of this world hovers and soaks into you.
2. The Transference is made.
3. It Transfigures you.
4. You reproduce what you have heard, felt, touched, saw,
Or have been a part of.

Identify. (Some examples)

1. What are my one on one relationships transferring?
2. What is going from me?
3. What is coming to me?
4. What is my circle of friends/associates at work like? Are they becoming like me, or am I becoming like them? Whatever we're becoming, is it like God/scriptural?
5. What is the spirit(s) of your family/relation?
6. What is the spirit(s) of this area? (Area's are different)
7. What is the spirit(s) of this nation?
